- Encourage neighborhood involvement in the maintenance and beautification of Baltimore's public parks through effective partnerships with Baltimore's Department of Recreation and Parks.
- Support greening efforts in Baltimore that are visible to the wider community.
- Support efforts to improve the Chesapeake Bay and its watersheds in Baltimore.

Goal: Baltimore will be a city with vibrant neighborhoods.

Strategies:

- Support community organizations that have a record of attracting financial investments in their neighborhood revitalization efforts.
- Support organizations that provide technical assistance and enhance the capabilities of groups that are working for community development in Baltimore.
