Scholarship Fund Eligibility Requirements

1. Applicant must be no older than twenty-four years of age and be a dependent child of an eligible employee of David A. Bramble, Inc.
2. Applicant must be a high school graduate or have a certificate of equivalency, i.e. a General Education Development certificate.
3. The education offered must be that of an accredited college, junior college or an approved business or trade school. Graduate school study will not be eligible for funding under this program.
4. Participation in the program will be on a semester to semester basis. Applicants will need to reapply every semester. However, previously approved applicants who maintain the required grade point average can expect to be re-approved based on the availability of funds in the program.
5. Applications must be submitted along with evidence of academic eligibility prior to the announced deadline.
6. Applicants must maintain a 2.0 grade point average to continue in the program.

RESTRICTIONS

1. The maximum funding available per individual will be twenty-five percent of the tuition billing attributable to the student.
