INSTITUTE HAS ALSO INSPIRED OTHER ORGANIZATIONS TO CONTRIBUTE THEIR
TALENT, NETWORKS AND ENERGY UNDER A SIMILAR CAUSE SUCH AS THE INSTITUTES
ENTREPRENEURSHIP WEEK/USA EFFORT WHERE MORE THAN 1100 ORGANIZATIONS

POINT OF VIEW. THE PUBLIC FORUM INSTITUTE HAS CHOSEN TO ONLY ACCEPT

FUNDING FROM ORGANIZATIONS WILLING TO ACCEPT ITS EDITORIAL INDEPENDENCE

SOMETHING ESSENTIAL IF THE INSTITUTE IS TO SERVE IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST

AND BRING IMPARTIAL DIALOGUE TO LOCAL COMMUNITIES.

ALL PUBLIC FORUM INSTITUTE PROGRAMS WITHOUT EXCEPTION ARE OPEN TO THE

PUBLIC AND FREE OF CHARGE. AS A RESULT EACH ACTIVITY ENGAGES A WIDE

VARIETY OF CITIZENS. THE DOZENS OF FORUMS ON HEALTH CARE FOR EXAMPLE,

ATTRACTED INTERESTED CITIZENS RANGING FROM THOSE WITHOUT HEALTH INSURANCE

TO SENIORS ON MEDICARE. EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES ON ENTREPRENEURSHIP ATTRACT

MOSTLY AN UNDER 30 DEMOGRAHIC INTERESTED IN EXPLORING THEIR POTENTIAL TO

GIVE BACK TO AMERICAS ECONOMY AND PURSE A DREAM OF STARTING UNLEASHING AN

IDEA.

A COUPLE OF PROJECTS THAT SERVE AS EXAMPLES INCLUDE THE PUBLIC FORUMS ON HEALTH CARE. WHILE THE INSTITUTE HAS HELD MORE THAN 500 PUBLIC FORMS ON HEALTHCARE, BETWEEN JANUARY AND NOVEMBER 2006 THE PUBLIC FORUM INSTITUTE ORGANIZED 24 FORUMS ON HEALTH CARE OFFERING THE OPPORTUNITY FOR THE PUBLIC TO LEARN ABOUT THE HEALTH CARE SYSTEM AND EXPRESS AN INFORMED VIEW AS TO HOW TO IMPROVE IT.
