ISSUES: Does 5480 Club Inc. (5480) continue to qualify for exempt status under IRC 501(c)(7)? If not, does 5480 qualify for exempt status under IRC 501(c)(2)?

FACTS: 5480 has the sole purpose of holding title and maintaining the facilities for the Knights of Columbus, Lodge 5480 (K of C). The Title to the property is in the name of the 5480 Club, Inc. 5480 has income from rental of the hall for social functions by the K of C and the public. 5480 does not provide any social activities for the K of C. 5480 pays all maintenance, repairs and improvements expenses for the facility. 5480 was incorporated on July 16, 1964 and applied for and was granted IRC 501(c)(7) exempt status in 1967. IRC 501(c)(2) was added to the IRC in 1954. K of C is a member of a group ruling exempt as a fraternal beneficiary organization under IRC 501(c)(8).

LAW: IRC 501(c)(2). Comparations organized for the exclusive purpose of holding title to import, collecting language the law comparations are expenses. to an organization which itself is exempt under this section.

IRC 501(c)(7). Clubs organized for pleasure, recreation, and other nonprofitable purposes, substantially all of the activities of which are for such purposes and no part of the net earnings of which inures to the b3nefit of any private shareholder.

Rev Rul 81-108, Title holding corporation; leasehold interest in an office building. A corporation that holds a leasehold interest in an office building, derives all its income from subleasing space in the building to the general public, and turns over the net rents to its exempt parent qualifies for exemption under section 501(c)(2) of the Code.

Rev Rul 69-381, Corporations organized to hold title to property for exempt organizations. A title holding corporation that derives income from rental of real property to the general public is not precluded from exemption under section 501(c)(2) of the Code.

Rev Rul 77-429, Accumulation of income; title-holding corporation. An exempt title-holding corporation may retain part of its income each year to apply to indebtedness on property to which it holds title: the transaction will be treated as if the income had been turned over to the exempt parent and the latter had used such income to make a capital contribution to the title-holding corporation which, in turn, applied such contribution to the indebtedness.

Rev Rul 71-544, An exempt organization receiving support from a title holding company must exercise some control or ownership over the title holding company supporting it.

TAXPAYER'S POSITION: 5480 was formed to hold title to the property of its parent organization, the 5480 Chapter of the Knights of Columbus as stipulated in the K of C charter. The current officers do not know the purpose of the original designation as an exempt organization under IRC 501(c)(7).

GOVERNMENT'S POSITION: 5480 is operating as a title holding company exempt under IRC 501(c)(2). It does not provide any social activities for its parent or any other organization. Its income is from rental of the facility to the public and its parent; rental income is allowed under 501(c)(2). Other income is investment income, also allowed under 501(c)(2).

Traditionally, investment in stocks and bonds is an allowable source of income under IRC 501(c)(2). It is not proscribed by the regulations and is not prohibited by the restrictions on "business" income (as a primary source of income). Clearly, an organization exempt under IRC 501(c)(2) may invest in stocks and bonds and passively collect the income from these investments. However, permissible investment activities should be distinguished from the active "business" of securities trading.

Control over the 5480 Club is vested in the officers of the Knights of Columbus Chapter 5480 since the K of C appoints the officers of the 5480 Club.

CONCLUSION: 5480 subsection should be reclassified from IRC 501(c)(7) to 501(c)(2) effective the first day of the period of the audit January 1 2006.
