2009 Year in Review

PRESERVATION PROJECTS:

Partnership Program:

Our Partner Program continued this year with one organization:

- **Cultural Survival.** They publish a quarterly magazine in which we have a 3-4 page article utilizing excerpts from our event series. The presentation is transcribed and printed with photos provided by us. A short segment of the film is then posted on both our and their websites. This same presentation is also translated into Spanish and four other indigenous Guatemalan languages and produced for broadcast on 148 local Guatemalan radio stations. This widely expands our exposure both here and around the world.

Film Projects:

We collaborated again with producer and director, Arna Vodenos on the additional footage of the next film in the series featuring Anank Nunink Nunkai, a Shuar shaman from Ecuador. We were still waiting for the final edit of film when RRF closed its headquarters at the end of 2009.

EDUCATION/OUTREACH PROGRAMS:

Healing Nautilus Programs

This year we hosted 12 programs in the Nautilus space in order to educate, entertain, and give voice to indigenous healers and wisdom keepers. All events in the space are free to the public. Presenters were drawn from our direct contacts, our partners and other contacts developed from our Discretionary Fund Grant Program and meetings at events and conventions the staff attended.

Healing Nautilus Exhibition

We changed the exhibit in the Nautilus in June to showcase Dine' healer Walking Thunder to highlight our work with Walking Thunder and the art and healing of sandpainting. We organized a grand opening event, a movie preview with Walking Thunder and movie director and producer, Arna Vodenos, and a display on the process of sandpainting from gathering the stones, grinding

them to completion of a sandpainting. Arna Vodenos also made us an 8 minute clip of the film for the Nautilus space that played continuously during the sandpainting exhibit.

Public School Programs

This year we did two school programs in northern Arizona. In the spring we presented Kokomon and Aeshah, from Ghana, West Africa. They spoke about the arts of drumming and movement, which are used to explore the art of rhythm and sound, as taught by the indigenous Ga people of West Africa. In the fall we presented Anank Nunink Nunkai, a Shuar *Uwishin* (traditional healer), from the Ecuadorian Amazon rainforest. Anank's presentation was about plants and animals of the Amazon for the younger students. For the older students, he addressed indigenous *permaculture*, the healing properties of the plants, and the wonders of the rainforest.

EDUCATION/OUTREACH PROGRAMS:

Website Redesign

Our new website has been launched with a new look and content. It has the added features of a shopping cart and a "donate here" feature. We reviewed and re-wrote the content and changed photographs for the site. We began the work to make the website much more of an educational feature of the foundation in hope of utilizing information collected in a more accessible way. We also began to put links on the website to other organizations for people to get more information about various subjects.

Gift Shop/Exhibition Space

We provide the opportunity to further educate through showing the public what indigenous healing/healers looks like and offering the public the chance to purchase some of these items, including the books from the "Profiles in Healing" series we have purchased. We are obtaining merchandise from several countries in Africa and Guatemala and directly from some of the healers/cultures that our books reference.

Public Awareness

We continued to broaden our public awareness in the Sedona area through involvement in the Chamber of Commerce, giving tours to the OSHA elders group, making the conference room available for the monthly meeting of Sedona Therapist, and actively pursuing written articles in magazines and newspapers. In 2009 we again received multiple articles written in Sedona Monthly magazine, Cultural Survival Quarterly, Kudos newspaper, Red Rock News newspaper, Verde Independent newspaper and Earth Odyssey newspaper. In addition we were mentioned in several additional outlets in relationship to the publication of Nancy Connor's book, Shamans of the World, published and promoted by Sounds True.

Also this year, we hosted the 13 Indigenous Grandmothers at the Creative Life Center in December as the final presentation for the year. In a very special evening, over 100 members of the local community were given the rare opportunity to sit with the Grandmothers' council and listened to songs not often heard by people outside of their native cultures. In addition, the grandmothers shared sacred stories of their people and spoke about their individual journeys which brought them together to pray for Mother Earth and all of her inhabitants.

DISCRETIONARY FUND GRANT PROGRAM:

The DF grant program was suspended for the 2009 Program year.

FUND RAISING:

We spoke with a grant writer and a fundraiser whose focus is events and auctions, and created a fundraising strategy, including a membership campaign. We were able to organize three successful events in 2009 and began working with Cultural Survival to increase the effectiveness of our partnership program. However, these efforts were not enough to make up for a lack of funding from our major donor, resulting in the closure of our headquarters at the end of 2009.
