ACT disburses funds directly to the school's Financial Aid Office with a letter indicating that funds are for full-time enrollment in undergraduate studies and that proceeds may be used only for tuition, fees, books, supplies and curriculum-required materials associated with the academic year for which the funds have been disbursed. The STAP and YES programs are administered by Air Force personal working out of the Base Education offices at bases participating in the programs with oversight by the Society's headquarters offices in Arlington, Virginia. For these programs, students must provide invoices or financial statements from the school that identify the student, curriculum and costs before any grants are issued.
