#### **Statement of Program Service Accomplishments 2009**

**Save Blackwater Canyon**: In 2009 Friends of Blackwater (FOB) continued to ask the Forest Service and the Fish and Wildlife Service to protect the Blackwater Canyon Trail. Unauthorized logging across from the trail was publicized. FOB mailed out newsletters on the issues, placed petitions asking for federal protections at businesses and met with state and federal officials to educate them about the value of the Blackwater Trail.

Total expenses \$74,925.57

Friends of Blackwater filed a notice letter and brought a lawsuit against the federal government for the Fish and Wildlife Service's delisting of the endangered West Virginia Northern flying squirrel. FOB organized a group letter to President Obama on the delisting issue. Under the SOS Save Our Squirrel Coalition we wrote FOIAs, managed website information, e-mails, newsletters, and petitions on the issue.

Total expenses \$82,587.26

North Fork Watershed Project: FOB did water monitoring on the North Fork of the Blackwater, testing for acid mine drainage (AMD). The North Fork Watershed Project of FOB continued to monitor work on two water treatment projects on the Albert Highwall to remediate this acid mine drainage water pollution degrading the North Fork. The Project worked with high school teachers to set up a program to present information on this issue to students. The Project began work on a trail in the Thomas City Park that abuts the North Fork Lake. Local high school students worked on the trail after hearing about trail building in North Fork Project presentations at school. The report on the North Branch of the Potomac was completed.

Total expenses \$122,723.27

**Keep Dolly Sods Wild**: FOB supported litigation, research and networking to Keep Dolly Sods Wild and mitigate or prevent the damage to citizens and wildlife from industrial wind turbines constructed on the Allegheny Front next to Dolly Sods and the Monongahela National Forest. Bats killed in large numbers at wind facilities became the subject of FOB research. A new threat to bats from the fatal white –nose syndrome was covered in FOB newsletter and e-news announcements. FOB joined with several national groups to pressure Congress to address this issue.

Total expenses \$3,703.10

The J.R. Clifford Project hosted a Celebration of the Life and Works of J.R. Clifford in conjunction with celebrating his inclusion in the US Postal Service's 2009 Civil Rights Pioneer Commemorative Stamp Series in February. The Project educated citizens about JR Clifford, West Virginia's first African-American lawyer who fought in the Civil War, was a newspaper publisher and a co-founder of the Niagara Movement, the predecessor of the NAACP. In 2009 the Project did presentations on Clifford's life to school assemblies around the state.

Total expenses \$19,179.47

**MON PLAN:** Friends of Blackwater and others challenged federal gas lease sales on the Monongahela National Forest at Brushy Run, a native trout stream near Seneca Rocks on the edge of the Seneca Rocks/Spruce Knob National Recreation Area. After the protest letter the proposed gas lease was dropped from the sale.

Total expenses \$5,000.00
