OVER 375 PEOPLE ATTEND THE EVENT, WHICH INCLUDED A MEAL, SILENT AUCTION, AND AUCTION OF THE TOP JUNIOR LIVESTOCK ENTRIES. THE PROCEEDS FROM THIS EVENT ALLOWED THE FOUNDATION TO RETURN OVER \$40,000 IN SALES PROCEEDS TO YOUTH LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS.

THE FOUNDATION ALSO CONTINUED A PROGRAM IN WHICH SPONSORSHIP FUNDS WERE OBTAINED FROM PUREBRED LIVESTOCK PRODUCERS. THESE FUNDS WERE THEN AWARDED, IN THE FORM OF \$1,000 ANIMAL PURCHASE CERTIFICATES, BY RANDOM DRAWING TO FIVE YOUTH LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS TO ASSIST THEM IN PURCHASING ANIMALS FROM THE PARTICIPATING BREEDERS.

THE FOUNDATION ALSO CONTINUED THE SUPREME BEEF HEIFER AWARD PROGRAM WHICH RECOGNIZES THE TOP JUNIOR BEEF LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS AT THE OZARK EMPIRE FAIR. A TOTAL OF \$10,850 WAS DISTRIBUTED TO 4-H AND FFA MEMBERS.

ESTABLISHED IN 2003, THE OZARK EMPIRE FAIR FOUNDATION IS A NON-PROFIT 501(C)(3) ORGANIZATION WHOSE MISSION IS TO PROVIDE AGRICULTURAL YOUTH SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS, AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR MAJOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE OZARK EMPIRE FAIRGROUNDS AND ITS LIVESTOCK FACILITIES.
