TRUST AGREEMENT made this 2nd day of January, 1994, between O. TEMPLE SLOAN, JR. of Raleigh, North Carolina, hereinafter referred to as the Donor, and CAROL C. SLOAN, CARSON S. HENLINE, MALCOLM C. GRAHAM, GEORGE C. TURNER, and W. GERALD THORNTON, as Trustees of this Trust, hereinafter sometimes referred to as the Board of Trustees.

- 1. Name of Trust. The name of this trust shall be the O. TEMPLE SLOAN, JR. FOUNDATION (hereinafter "the Foundation").
- 2. <u>Purpose of Trust</u>. The purposes of this Foundation are to devote and apply the property of the Foundation and the income to be derived therefrom exclusively for educational, scientific, literary, religious or charitable purposes, as defined under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (herein the "Code"), which purposes shall be selected from time to time (but at least annually) by the Board of Trustees and shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following:
 - (a) To financially assist, through grants, loans, fellowships, scholarship awards or otherwise, the education of individuals, selected by the Board of Trustees, who desire to study at an accredited four year college or university and who need financial assistance in order to make such study possible.
 - (b) The making of contributions to qualified \$501(c)(3) organizations in order that such organizations may improve, expand or otherwise more effectively carry out the purposes for which they are operated; provided, the Board of Trustees shall retain, sufficient control over any funds disbursed to organizations which themselves are not exempt under \$501(c)(3) and shall maintain any necessary records to show that any funds distributed to such organizations will be used exclusively for one or more of the purposes specified in \$501(c)(3).

The Trustees shall have complete discretion in selecting which of the above purposes to fund, determining the amount to distribute and determining

the time to distribute the income or principal of the trust. However, the adjusted net income as defined in Section 4942 of the Code must be distributed or set aside each year for one or more of the above purposes.

- 3. <u>Selection Procedures</u>. The selection of individuals or organizations to be grantees of the Foundation shall be by majority vote of the Board of Trustees. The selection of individuals shall meet the following additional requirements:
 - (a) The trustees shall solicit nominations from guidance counselors of high schools selected by the trustees. In addition, any interested high school senior may apply on their own initiative.
 - (b) No relative or issue of the trustees or of O. Temple Sloan, Jr., shall be eligible to be a grantee.
 - (c) The grantee must meet or exceed the entrance requirements of the college or university they have selected to attend.
 - (d) The grantee must graduate from high school in good standing.
 - (e) The grantee must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Board of Trustees the need for financial assistance to pursue higher education.
 - (f) In the opinion of the Board of Trustees determined through personal interview, written references provided by the applicant, and such other investigation as the Board deems appropriate, the grantee must have exhibited high standards of character, honesty, and morality and demonstrate the potential for hard work, leadership, and good citizenship.
 - (g) The applicant or applicants meeting these requirements who the Board of Trustees determines by majority vote to be the most likely to succeed in higher education shall be the grantee or grantees for that year.
- 4. <u>Individual Grant Procedures</u>. For each grant, loan, fellowship, scholarship, or other individual funding provided by the Foundation, the Board of Trustees shall:

- (a) Make arrangements to receive reports of the courses taken and grades received (or progress on papers or projects) by the grantee in each academic period, and have such reports verified by the appropriate educational institution at least once a year;
- (b) Investigate any reports which indicate that Foundation funds are not being used as intended and, where such investigation determines improprieties, withhold further payments and take reasonable steps to recover or restore the improperly used funds; and
- (c) Retain records pertaining to all donated Foundation funds which shall include (i) all information related to the qualification of potential grantees, (ii) identification of grantees, (iii) specification of the amount and purpose of each loan, scholarship, grant or award and (iv) follow-up information gathered to ensure the funds are properly used.
- 5. <u>Trust Assets</u>. The property to constitute this Trust as herein provided shall consist of the assets set forth in the attached schedule hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and such other property and assets as the Donor of this Trust, or anyone else, may from time to time hereafter transfer by will or otherwise to the Board of Trustees to be accepted by it. Such property shall be transferred to the Board of Trustees to be held by it in trust and disposed of as herein provided.
- 6. <u>Use of Foundation's Assets</u>. The Board of Trustees, except as hereinafter limited, shall have the power and authority and is directed to distribute from time to time exclusively for the aforesaid purposes, each year, such amounts of income or principal of this Foundation as it in its discretion may appoint, order, or direct, subject to the provisions of this Agreement. The Board of Trustees shall make distributions either (1) directly for the purposes described in this Agreement, or (2) by contributions to organizations which are exempt under Section 501(c)(3), and contributions to which are deductible under Sections 170(c), 2522(a), and 2055(a) of the Code. Notwithstanding the above, no part of the property or net earnings of the

Foundation shall inure or be payable to or for the benefit of any individual except as reasonable compensation for services actually rendered by such individual or as payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Agreement, none of which shall be for the benefit of any individual prohibited from benefitting from an exempt Section 501(c)(3) organization under the Code. No part of the direct or indirect activities of this Foundation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or of participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision herein to the contrary, this Foundation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may be amended, or by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Sections 170(c), 2522(a), and 2055(a) of such Code and Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended. The Board of Trustees shall distribute amounts pursuant to this Agreement for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws. The Foundation and its Trustees, officers, and managers shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code, shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined Section 4943(c) of the Code, shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject the Foundation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code, and shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code. The Foundation shall not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color, sex or national or ethnic origin.

7. Action of Board of Trustees. Except as herein otherwise provided, the decisions and acts of a majority of the voting members of the Board of Trustees shall be and constitute an exercise of the trust powers and

discretion and acts of such majority of the Board of Trustees shall constitute and be taken as the decisions and acts of the entire Board of Trustees.

- 8. Meeting of Board of Trustees. Meetings of the Board of Trustees may be held where ten (10) days prior notice has been given to all the members of the Board of Trustees and two of such members attend such meeting, but to make any action taken at such meeting effective written assent to such action must be obtained from such number of members as are not in attendance, which, together with the votes of those in attendance, will show that a majority of the members of the Board of Trustees assented to such action. Any member of the Board of Trustees may vote at any meeting by letter as well as personally, but such letter must clearly state the action upon which the vote is cast and the vote thereon.
- Powers of Board of Trustees. Subject to the provisions of this 9. Agreement, the Board of Trustees shall have the power and authority, within its discretion and exercise of judgment, to sell and dispose of any of the property transferred to the Foundation by this instrument, or subsequently acquired, and may invest and reinvest the income or funds thereby obtained, or the income from time to time accumulated, in any other property which, in its discretion, it may determine is wise and proper. The investments and reinvestment made by the Board of Trustees shall not be limited to those which are commonly known as those in which trust funds are authorized to be invested under the laws of North Carolina, provided that no such investments shall be made which create a tax liability under Section 4944 of the Code. of Trustees shall not be responsible for any loss arising out of any investments made by it in the exercise of its judgment and discretion. Board of Trustees shall have power and authority to give a proxy to anyone selected by the Board of Trustees to vote any of the shares and securities held or to be held in this Foundation at any meeting of any corporation having issued such shares or securities.

The operation of any business involves certain risks of loss. Therefore, the Trustees shall not be liable for any loss resulting from the retention and operation of any business, or the holding, selling, or voting of

the stock of any corporation, owned by the Donor. The operation or administration of any such business or corporate stock shall be deemed to be undertaken upon the express request of the Donor, even if the same is deemed to be a speculative enterprise.

In addition, the Board of Trustees, and its successors in the Trust. shall have and exercise, subject to the limitations herein provided, all the rights and powers incident to the ownership of all the properties, real and personal, held by them from time to time belonging to this Foundation, as fully and absolutely as though they were the owners of such properties in their own right. The Board of Trustees and its successors shall have power to deposit the monies and securities belonging to this Foundation from time to time in such banks and safe deposits and trust companies as they may from time to time select. Without in any way limiting the generality of the foregoing and subject to the North Carolina General Statutes Section 32-26, all the Carolina General and authority set forth in North Section 32-27, as amended, are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part of this instrument and such powers are intended to be in addition to and not in substitution of the power conferred by law.

Notwithstanding any other provision hereof, no power or authority shall be exercised by the Board of Trustees in any manner or for any purposes whatsoever which may jeopardize the status of the Foundation as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended nor shall the Board of Trustees engage in any act prohibited by this Agreement.

appoints Carol C. Sloan to serve for a term of five (5) years from the date hereof, Carson S. Henline to serve for a term of four (4) years from the date hereof, Malcolm C. Graham to serve for a term of three (3) years from the date hereof, George C. Turner to serve for a term of two (2) years from the date hereof, and W. Gerald Thornton to serve for a term of one (1) year from the date hereof, as Trustees of this Foundation. Thereafter, the term of each appointed Trustee shall be five (5) years. Any vacancy occurring in the Board

of Trustees occasioned by expiration of term, death, resignation, refusal or inability to serve, or otherwise shall be filled by the Grantor, if living, by the Grantor's wife if the Grantor is not living, or by the majority vote of the Grantor's living issue, per stirpes, who are over the age of eighteen if both Grantor and Grantor's wife are deceased. Every such new Trustee so appointed from time to time shall serve for the remainder of the term being filled or, in the case of an expired term, for a term of five years, and such Trustee shall have, possess, and exercise all the powers, authority, and discretion by this instrument conferred upon the present members of the Board of Trustees, as fully and effectually as though he, she, or it were named by this instrument as one of the original Board of Trustees.

- 11. Number of Trustees. At all times, at least one Trustee shall be the spouse of Grantor or a lineal descendant of the Grantor. The Board of Trustees shall consist of at least five (5) members; however, the Board of Trustees by majority vote may increase or decrease (but not below the minimum) the number of Trustees on the Board. Any vacancy created by an increase in the number of Trustees shall be filled in the same manner as provided in paragraph 10, above.
- designates Carol C. Sloan as the first Chairman of the Board of Trustees to serve one year from the creation of this Trust, and as many successive years as he may be elected as Chairman by the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall have power to appoint a Vice Chairman and may from time to time appoint a Secretary and fix the duties to be performed by the Secretary. The Board of Trustees shall have the power and authority to engage or employ any other person or persons it may desire to employ or engage for the performance of any services to the Foundation, including an Executive Director.
- 13. Compensation and Expenses. The Board of Trustees is authorized to fix whatever, if any, reasonable compensation from time to time which shall be paid to its members or any of them for the services they may render to this Trust at such amount as the Board of Trustees may from time to time determine. The Board of Trustees is authorized to fix the compensation of any person or

persons engaged or employed by it for the Trust, and may fix the compensation of such person or persons. In no event shall any compensation ever be paid to any person after he has made a transfer of property to this Foundation as a contribution. The Board of Trustees shall have power and authority to incur any other expenses or to do any other act or acts which it may consider necessary and proper to the effective administration of this Trust. The expenses of the Board of Trustees, and its compensation, if any, the Secretary's salary, and all other compensation, and all other expenses of administration of this Trust, shall first be paid each year, or provision made therefor, out of the income of the Foundation before any distribution is made therefrom for any one year. No Trustee shall be eligible for any financial distribution from the Foundation other than for reimbursement or reasonable compensation for actual service rendered.

- 14. Accounting. The Board of Trustees shall make such reports annually of its administration of this Foundation as may be required by law.
- 15. Contributions from Others. If any person or persons at any time is or are disposed to make gifts or bequests to the Foundation, power and authority is hereby conferred upon the Board of Trustees to receive such gifts and bequests and to apply the principal and income therefrom to the purposes of this Foundation, under the powers, authorities, and discretion contained in this Agreement; provided, that such gifts or bequests are not made upon any terms or conditions that would conflict with the uses, purposes and provisions of this Agreement and the administration thereof by the Board of Trustees, except that restrictions in such gifts and bequests may be agreed to by the Board of Trustees and accepted subject thereto if such acceptance shall not, in the opinion of the Trustees, jeopardize the Federal income tax exemption of this Trust pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Code as now in force or hereafter amended.
- 16. <u>Creation of Corporation</u>. The Donor authorizes and empowers the Board of Trustees of the Foundation, or a majority of its members if they so desire, to form and organize a corporation for the uses and purposes provided for the Foundation by this Agreement, such corporation to be organized under

the laws of North Carolina, or any other State or under the laws of the United States, as may be determined by the Board of Trustees. Such corporation when organized shall have power to administer and control the affairs and property of the Foundation, and to carry out the uses, objects and purposes of this Foundation. Upon the creation and organization of such corporation, the Board of Trustees of this Foundation or a majority of its members is authorized and empowered to convey, transfer and deliver, to such corporation all the property and assets to which the Foundation may be or become entitled. It is the purpose of this provision that such corporation, if incorporated and organized as provided by this paragraph, shall take the place of the Trust and the Board of Trustees of this Foundation as if named in the first instance. Such corporation, if formed, shall have the same powers and authority as are vested in the Board of Trustees by this Agreement, subject to the same limitations and restrictions. The Board of Trustees of this Foundation, or a majority of its members, shall be the incorporators of such corporation. together with such other persons as may be chosen for the purpose, and the Board of Trustees shall constitute and act as the first Board of Directors of such corporation, together with such other persons as the Board of Trustees or a majority of its members may select. The application for charter, the provisions thereof, the organization, the by-laws, rules and regulations, and other provisions for the management of such corporation and its affairs and property, shall be such as the Board of Trustees or those persons then acting as such, or a majority of them shall determine, provided, however, that such corporation shall be organized and operated so as to qualify for exemption under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and its Regulations as they may then exist or as they may thereafter be amended.

17. Term of Trust. The term of this Trust shall continue forever unless the Trustees terminate it and distribute all of the principal and income, which action may be taken by unanimous vote of the Trustees. On such termination, the trust fund as then constituted shall be distributed to or for the use of such tax exempt organizations described under Section 501(c)(3), or

contributions to which are deductible under Sections 170(c), 2522(a), and 2055(a) of the Code, as the Trustees shall then select and determine.
