GRANT GUIDELINES- 2009

The Adele A. and Harold J. Westbrook Foundation, Inc., is a small private foundation established to provide grants, gifts and/or contributions to qualifying tax-exempt public charities, to support general charitable programs based in the United States. The Board of Directors sets policy and the Foundation is managed on a day-to-day basis by the Executive Director. The Board of Directors reviews grant applications that have been selected by the Executive Director as appropriate agencies, which reflect the charitable desires of the foundation. The Foundation's goals are to seek out and assist organizations that care for the needy in society, including those who cannot speak for themselves, victims of disasters and those whom the Foundation identifies over the years as appropriate beneficiaries in need of assistance. The Foundation will consider grant requests from appropriate public charity agencies that will benefit the widest spectrum of the public and special purpose programs, including those humane concerns which may be considered appropriate by the Board of Directors.

POLICIES AND INTERESTS:

- ➤ Grants are made only to organizations that have <u>current</u> tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and have been classified as "not a private foundation" as defined under section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code (public charities). A copy of the latest IRS status letter must be attached to the application form when submitted.
- ➤ In order for a grant request to be considered by the Foundation, the applying agency must complete the three page application form which can be obtained from the Executive Director by written request to the following address: The Adele A. and Harold J. Westbrook Foundation, Inc., P. O. Box 664, Midlothian, VA 23113. All requests for applications must be made well in advance of the July 31st deadline for the current year, since that deadline will preclude any further requests for applications for that year. No inquiries will be accepted after July 31st each year.

- > Generally, most grants will be designed for smaller organizations that operate in a cost efficient manner and may benefit from modest contributions. Most grants will be small, reflecting the Foundation's limited budget.
- ➤ The deadline for grant applications for the year 2009 is July 31, 2009. All applicants are encouraged to submit proposals well in advance of this date. It is likely that grants for the year 2009 will be awarded toward the end of the year. In the discretion of the Board, grants may be awarded to qualifying organizations without the necessity of a formal grant application. Such action will be taken when the Board is satisfied that the organization and activity to be supported are compatible with and further the goals of the Foundation.
- During the review process, the Executive Director may research your request through telephone inquiries, meetings or site visits. The Foundation prefers to initiate site visits, if needed, and generally discourages pre-application meetings. Organizations will be notified as to the status of each proposal after all screenings and evaluations have been completed.
- > The Foundation will not make grants intended directly or indirectly to support candidates for political office or to influence legislation.
- > The Board of Directors will review the final candidates for funding. The Board will select a limited number of proposals for funding that addresses most effectively the issues to which the board has given priority.
