On May 5, 2009, I filed the annual form 990-PF 'Return of Private Foundation' with the Federal Government.

Recognizing the requirements of Part VII A and the instructions on page 19, I went on-line to find the correct address in Columbia to which a copy should be sent. I then found all kinds of information regarding Public Charities. After reading this material, I decided that Telios needed to file an Application for Exemption with the SC Secretary of State, which I did

There were several pages which I completed to file this application, the final page of which advised me to click "finish"; which I did. After that, NOTHING!!!

On May 6, 2009, I called 1 803 734 1790 and enquired if I should expect any kind of confirmation in the mail.

The lady to whom I talked listened carefully, then asked me to hold. A moment later she came back and told me that we were now registered as an exempt organization, with registration # 16820. She also gave me a confirmation number: # 47606435. I next asked her for the correct address to which I should mail a copy of form 990-PF; she replied that as exempt organization, we were not required to file a copy with the Secretary of State. To me, this seems to conflict with the Federal requirements!

I asked if we would get any written confirmation and she replied "probably not". She noted, however, that an e-mail confirmation should have gone to >info@prnob.com< which was the e-mail address which I had provided in the on-line registration. I checked with Cindy, but she had not received any Telios related e-mails at this address
