HOWEVER, IF THE SOCIETY RECEIVED A NON-STANDARD CONTRIBUTION, THE DECISIONS OF WHETHER TO ACCEPT THE CONTRIBUTION AND HOW TO VALUE IT WOULD INVOLVE KEY MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL, INCLUDING THE PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT OF FINANCE, AS WELL AS DISCLOSURE TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.
