

NOTE K – SUMMARY STATEMENT OF SERVICES

Shelter for Battered Women and their Children

The shelter is staffed 24 hours a day. 73 women and 86 children were sheltered in 2009 for a total of 6,938 guest nights at an average of 42 days per guest.

24-hour Crisis Telephone Line

The crisis line provides referral service as well as information on shelter services. 3,673 crisis calls were received in 2009.

Referral Services

Resource information is provided on medical, legal, housing, educational, and other social services. 1,398 referrals were made to clients in 2009.

Support Groups

Two support groups meet each week. During the group sessions, women are assisted in addressing: the reality of the situation, dynamics of abuse, communication skills, building self-esteem, options available (jobs, housing, education, day care, etc.) and support systems (family, social service agencies, etc.). An average of 67 women attended support group sessions each month in 2009.

Children's Program

Fifty percent of the children sheltered have been physically abused by the father/step-father. Through the structured Children's Program, which is offered two times a week, the children are provided an opportunity to share their fears and concerns. The children are made aware that violence is not the appropriate way to solve problems. Over 183 different children and 54 teenagers attended this program in 2009.

School Curriculum Program

This program provides a preventive aspect by educating middle and high school students on the dynamics and dangers of abusive relationships. 236 presentations were made to 3,548 students in 2009. As a result of this program, intervention was provided to 19 middle school students and 26 elementary school students.

NOTE K – SUMMARY STATEMENT OF SERVICES (Continued)

Life Enrichment Program

This program provides training, education and case management needed to enhance a woman's chances of making a successful transition from victim to survivor. This training develops skills necessary to have a safe and healthy home for themselves and their children. The training focuses on subjects that provide personal skills in the area of economic independence, making decisions regarding the legal options available, obtaining employment, personal finance, nutrition education, parenting and nurturing, and other issues that strengthen and preserve the family. 93 new families participated in this program during 2009.

Legal Advocacy Program

This program includes the following services: inform battered women about their rights and their legal options, court accompaniment, orienting women to the court process, legal representation and referral to other service providers. Gateway House, Inc. provided 980 face-to-face contacts with victims in 2009. This included assistance with 193 Temporary Protective Orders and 313 Second Hearings and Other Civil Hearings.

Community Outreach Program

This program provides training for criminal justice and social service agencies, civic organizations, churches, schools, colleges, and other groups in the dynamics of abuse, needs of battered women and their children, as well as the services available at Gateway House, Inc. In 2009 Gateway House, Inc. staff spoke to 46 groups. 2,124 individuals attended these sessions. Another 236 persons participated in 13 in-service training sessions.

NOTE L – COMPENSATED ABSENCES

Employees of Gateway House are entitled to paid vacation, sick, and personal leave, depending on length of service and other factors. Employees and management have contracts or agreements that provide for compensated absences. It is impracticable to estimate the amount of compensation for future absences, and accordingly, no liability has been recorded in the accompanying financial statements. The Agency's policy is to recognize the costs of compensated absences when actually paid to employees.
