- 1. AFGHANISTAN (NGO No. 104)
 - a. Women's Center I, Kart-e-Seh, and Women's Center II, Dask-e-Barchee, Kabul. The second women's center was opened in 2008, moving deep into the Hazara District, reaching the poorest women in a section of Kabul, with more than 2½ million Hazara Afghan citizens are struggling to survive. Center 1 offered computer literacy and advanced Computer Skill Training for women, English I, II, III, and IV, More than 340 women are attending classes at Center I. Center II created literacy classes for adult Hazara women, basic sewing classes, small business techniques, and English language skills. Beneficiaries were more than 78 for Center II. Total women enrolled: 418

 Teacher training from U.S., Three Segments, Cost: 81,258

(In-Country Plan developed for Character and Integrity Training Schedule for Afghan Families, to be completed and implemented 2010)

Agricultural and Medical Projects delayed due to death of partners and temporary exits from Afghanistan. Women to the World remains in full hope.

11. BURKINA FASO, WEST AFRICA (NGO Registration Secure)

a. Lycee Technical and Language Center: WTW provided courses in English, Hygiene, International Business, Water Purification, Well Boring, and Greenhouse Growing. Eight (8) remote villages received personalized agribusiness training, with staff and translators. Cows were purchased and a veterinarian was hired to train women leadership, organized by Women to the World. Dental hygiene training and items were distributed to 400 elementary school age children. Women to the World provides a cutting-edge computer lab for Computer Literacy Classes, GED Pre-Testing and Mentoring Classes, Life Skills that include Financial Planning, Disease Prevention, Nutrition, Time Management, Professional Etiquettes, and optional counseling. Employment Sustainability and Job Placement are emphasized, with a beneficiary count of 459 adult women.
