# THIRD AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF TRUST OF THE GARY W. AND RUTH M. ROLLINS FOUNDATION

On December 19, 1991, Gary W. Rollins, R. Randall Rollins and Joe M. Young, as Trustees, entered into a Trust Agreement (the "Agreement") creating the Gary W. Rollins Foundation, which on December 10, 1993, was changed to the Gary W. and Ruth M. Rollins Foundation (the "Trust"). Under Item V of the Agreement, Gary W. Rollins has the right to amend the Agreement at any time and from time to time, by written instrument acknowledged by the Trustees, provided such amendment does not authorize the Trustees to conduct the affairs of the Trust in any manner or for any purpose contrary to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as in force or afterwards amended. Pursuant to such right, Gary W. Rollins hereby amends the Agreement as follows:

#### ITEM I OF THIRD AMENDMENT

The amendment of Item I made on December 10, 1993 in the First Amendment to the Declaration of Trust of The Gary W. and Ruth M. Rollins Foundation is canceled, deleted and shall be of no further force and effect. The following new amendment shall take the place of the canceled amendment:

#### "ITEM I

This trust shall be called The Gary W. Rollins Foundation, and shall be referred to hereinafter as "the Trust."

### ITEM II OF THIRD AMENDMENT

The amendment of Paragraph (e) of Item II made on December 10, 1993 in the First Amendment to the Declaration of Trust of The Gary W. and Ruth M. Rollins Foundation is canceled, deleted and shall be of no further force and effect. The following new amendment shall take the place of the canceled amendment:

"(e) The Trustees shall advise each charitable recipient of funds from the Trust that the gift was made from Gary W. Rollins Foundation."
