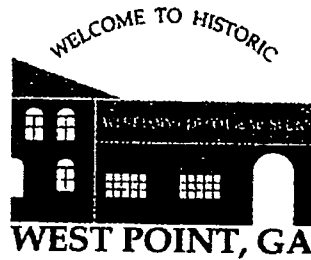

Attached you will find the requested documentation for the funds awarded to the West Point Depot and Museum Restoration Association by The Illges Foundation. This grant in the amount of \$30,000 was to be paid in three annual installments of \$10,000 for the years 2009, 2010 and 2011. As requested in the original grant application, these funds were used for the construction of a 70' x 30' covered pavilion which is used for community events, regional train watching excursions and also as an expansion of the banquet hall. This donation has allowed completion of the pavilion addition to the building. This documentation shall serve as an Annual ER Report.

A bid of \$47,500 was awarded to Zachry Construction on July 16, 2009. (Attachment 1) and work commenced on Jan 06, 2010. In kind services from the City of West Point as well as local contractors in the amount of \$6,150 reduced construction cost to \$41,350. A payment of \$20,000 was paid to Zachry Construction on January 14, 2010 at 50% completion and a payment of \$21,350 at 100% completion was issued on May 24, 2010. (See Attachments 2 and 3). Other enhancements such as railings, surface treatments and landscaping will be addressed in 2011.

Our mission statement is: "The Depot and Museum Associations' mission is to create a welcoming gateway for visitors traveling to West Point and for guests to journey back in time to discover the immense pride our community has for the city's southern history and heritage". This expansion is an integral part of that mission statement. The pavilion serves to accommodate the increasing number of guests present at functions held at the depot building as well as the visitors who have enjoyed the hospitality and information available in the museum. It is also used for after school programs centered on local history and historic preservation for middle school classes. A farmers market held on the pavilion is a popular spring and fall event. We are pleased that the state of Georgia recognizes and appreciates this historic restoration and has designated the facility as a Regional Visitors Center.

This expansion has increased the popularity and use of the facility. We are thankful that The Illges Foundation has supported this project. If you need further information, please give me a call at 706-645-6218.
