BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

RECIPIENTS SHALL COME UNDER THE FOLLOWING GROUPS:

A. Children and dependants of members in the American Association of State Troopers, Inc.

CRITERIA:

Applicant must be a high school graduate, must have maintained a 2.5 grade point average from last accredited school attended. Applicant shall submit a 500-word essay on "Why Education is Important to Me."

The Board of Directors of the AASTSF will have the authority to amend any part of Article I.

ARTICLE II

METHOD OF PAYMENT

SECTION 1. The scholarship shall be made in not less than two (2) payments. The Board of Directors shall implement policy to further define limitations.

SECTION 2. The scholarship may be discontinued or revoked for good and just cause, which shall include but not be limited to grade point average dropping below the required average, withdrawal from school, and failing to meet or comply with Foundation requirements.

ARTICLE III

MEETINGS

SECTION 1. The American Association of State Troopers Scholarship Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors shall meet no less than one (1) time each calendar year to conduct the business of the Foundation.

SECTION 2. All applicants must have the completed applications submitted to the AASTSF by the set deadline in order to be considered for the closest academic year, or the scholarship applicant will be considered at the next meeting. All scholarships will be approved by the Board of Directors or its designee.

ARTICLE IV

PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE

SECTION 1. Except as provided in these Constitution and By-Laws, "Roberts Rules of Order Revised", shall govern the conduct and deliberation of this Foundation.

ARTICLE V

DESCRIPTION OF FOUNDATION SEAL

SECTION 1. The Corporation Seal of the American Association of State Troopers Scholarship Foundation, Inc. and shall read the same.
