<u>Alzheimer's Disease Initiative</u> - Provides respite care services, including in-home services for the victims of Alzheimer's disease and provides training for caregivers of these victims.

(Expenses \$ 474,102 including grants of \$ 414,525 (Revenue \$0)

Emergency Home Energy for the Elderly – Provides assistance for low income elderly persons who are in danger of having their power turned off due to non-payment. Fan purchases and air conditioner repair are part of the summer program and blanket purchases are part of the winter program.

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) - Provides, but not limited to, job creation, food program subsidies, and the expansion of existing social service programs.

Aging and Disability Resource – Establishes a single, coordinated system of information and access to community-based services for seniors and their caregivers.

(Expenses \$ 248,659 including grants of \$ 28,373 (Revenue \$0)

Home Care for the Elderly (HCE) – Encourages the provision of care for elders age 60 and older in family-type living arrangements in private homes as an alternative to nursing homes or other institutional care. A basic subsidy is provided for support and maintenance of the elderly, including medical costs. A special subsidy may also be provided for additional services and supplies which are needed.

(Expenses \$ 173,847 including grants of \$ 151,193 (Revenue \$0)

Respite for Elders Programs Living in Everyday Families (RELIEF) – Offers an expansion of currently available in-home respite, specifically evening and weekend respite, in order to increase the ability of a family unit to continue to care for a homebound elderly individual beyond the basic provisions of current public programs.

(Expenses \$ 173,010 including grants of \$ - (Revenue \$0)

<u>Car Fit</u> – Education program provides older adults the opportunity to find out how well their vehicles "fit" them and provides information and materials to enhance safety.

(Expenses \$ 149,125 including grants of \$ - (Revenue \$0)

<u>Serving Health Insurance Needs of Elders (SHINE)</u> – Offers free health insurance counseling to elders and their caregivers. Trained volunteers provide information, counseling and assistance in areas related to Medicare, Medicaid, long-term care insurance, managed care and supplemental insurance.

(Expenses \$ 122,311 including grants of \$ - (Revenue \$0)

<u>Medicaid</u> <u>Waiver</u> – Assists area service providers with the process of selecting and registering clients in the Medicaid Waiver program. The overall goal of the process is to select the most appropriate clients in order to maximize Medicaid Waiver earnings for the district.

(Expenses \$ 69,149 including grants of \$ - (Revenue \$0)

Florida Pioneer Network – Provides leadership and support of culture change in long-term care, involvi

<u>Florida Pioneer Network</u> – Provides leadership and support of culture change in long-term care, involving moving from the current medical model of care to a social model of care in nursing homes and other long-term care facilities.

(Expenses \$ 68,199 including grants of \$ (6,574) (Revenue \$0)

<u>Retirement Research</u> – Provides funding to assess nursing home culture and assist with implementation of changes to make institutions more homelike. The negative grant was a return of prior year's overpayment.

(Expenses \$ 63,771 including grants of \$ 14,081 (Revenue \$0)

<u>Winter Park Health</u> <u>Foundation</u> - Provides grants for projects which enhance the quality of life and community for older adults, including Healthy IDEAs depression screening, fall prevention, and dining enhancement in institutional settings

(Expenses \$ 62,691 including grants of \$ - (Revenue \$0)

<u>Triage (CCE)</u> – Provides in-depth telephone assessment and consultation for older adults and caregivers who have social service needs. Triage staff assess older adults who are in need of home and community based services or who are at risk of nursing home placement to see if they are eligible for Medicaid Waiver or similar services (such as Long Term Diversion services).

(Expenses \$ 40,915 including grants of \$ - (Revenue \$0)

Assisted Living Facility Trainer (ALF) – Provides training to Assisted Living Facility administrators and managers as required by Florida Statute. Training is conducted by a certified trainer. Revenue is earned from registration fees and sales of textbooks and curriculum materials.

(Expenses \$ 20,488 including grants of \$ - (Revenue \$0)

<u>Community Health Improvement Council</u> – Funds the Senior Assessment Program, a three-year pilot project to demonstrate the inherent benefits of convenient, accessible heath care access points in an integrated system of comprehensive medical and psychosocial services. This project represents an innovative approach to holistic, culturally-sensitive, geniatric care management

(Expenses \$ 16,929 including grants of \$ 150 (Revenue \$0)

Elder <u>Driver Safety</u> – Provides competence testing for medically at-risk drivers, which includes computer-based assessment of mental and motor skills, and, where appropriate, road test administered by trained professionals. Mobility counseling is provided

(Expenses \$ 9,958 including grants of \$ 9,958 (Revenue \$0)

<u>Dental</u> <u>Program</u> – Program to serve elderly dental patient needs for dentures and other dental services not otherwise covered under other programs.

(Expenses \$ 8,337 including grants of \$ 105 (Revenue \$0)

Medicaid Benefit Outreach Assistant - Provides for an outreach program targeted to individuals eligible for low-income subsidy, Medicare savings programs, and Medicare Part D.

<u>Disaster Relief</u> – Provides emergency assistance to provide disaster relief and recovery through the provision of needed services to assist older persons and caregivers.
