These funds and funds from the State were used to coordinate services with its partners in four counties. This included meeting with and assisting organizations applying for State and Federal dollars. Met with individuals interested in opening facilities to house the homeless. Provided information and referral services to people looking for shelter or those looking for assistance to prevent them from losing their housing. Educated members of the community about homelessness. Worked with partners to address the needs, develop plans, and research homeless solutions. This process was based on comparison of similar positions in the local communities, similar positions in local Coalitions in the State of Florida, and the amount of State funding available for this purpose.
