Since 2006 Welcome House has partnered with St. Elizabeth Healthcare,
the flagship healthcare provider in Northern Kentucky, to help homeless

emergency rooms as healthcare providers of last resort because they
usually do not have medical insurance, and are consequently unable to
receive care from other providers. Welcome House conducts outreach in
the community by visiting the Cold Shelter, libraries, and other places
