At the annual meeting of the credit union such members so nominated must be approved by a majority vote of the membership present at the meetings. During the meeting any other question that arise from the members present at the annual meeting may be presented to the board for consideration. Members have the right at any time to attend a monthly board meeting to bring business to the attention of the board to which the board will give consideration.

At the first board meeting held subsequent to the filing of the Form 990 the return is presented to the Board for review in those cases in which the review was not conducted prior to filing the return.
F990_P06_S0B_L12c	Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c	Officers and Directors are required annually to disclose that the officer or director is not engaged in any relationship that would constitute a conflict of interest. The forms are signed by each officer and director and are maintained in the Human Resources department. If a conflict of interest arises an officer or director is required to bring the conflict to the attention of the CEO and entire Board of Directors. The credit unions compliance officer monitors any potential conflicts of interest as well. State examiners review loan and savings accounts of officers and directors annually.
F990_P06_S0B_L15	Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 15	The Board of Directors evaluates the salary and performance of the President/CEO annually. The Board compares the performance against targets established in the previous year and establishes new progress goals for the following year. For all employees the credit union utilizes the services of an employment specialist to determine pay ranges for each job position. The President/CEO uses the report of the employment specialist to set salaries for all officers and employees of the credit union. The report was most recently updated within the last three years.

The financial statements are also available for viewing or printing at National Credit Union Administration wiebsite. The documents of organization and the conflict of interest policy are available upon request.
