South Census data, both data sets will be considered Ensure that staff positions are properly aligned with UWA position codes and assess whether the salary structure for each position is appropriate based on the duties of the position Compare the ranges with appropriately aged data from salary/benefit surveys of local businesses of comparable size Compare the range with relevant data available from local branches of the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) and the Human Resource Association of Northeast Tennessee (HRANET) Consider comparative wage information, cost of living data and other pertinent information. B. The salary ranges provide the structure for merit increases. The ranges will be reviewed by the Human Resources Committee on a bi-annual basis and updated as needed. C.
