Vine also shipped a 40-foot ocean container of wheelchairs & disability items from Norton, KS to Bethel Ministries in Chimaltenango, Guatemala - with an average wholesale value of \$138,400.

In March, Vine shipped a 40-foot ocean container from Brunswick, GA to our distribution center in San Jose Pinula containing assorted Rx & over-the-counter drugs with an average wholesale value of \$4,442,209. Vine also shipped two 40-foot ocean containers from Taft, CA to the Bethel ministries in Chimaltenango, Guatemala including wheelchairs & other disability items - with an average wholesale value of \$138,255 - & - \$159,650. In May, Vine shipped a 40-foot ocean container of wheelchairs & disability items from Norton, KS to Bethel Ministries in Chimaltenango, Guatemala - with an average wholesale value of \$106,500.

In **June**, Vine shipped a 40-foot ocean container of wheelchairs, disability items, medical suuplies, & medical equipment from Lynden, WA to our distribution center in San Jose Pinula, Guatemala with an average wholesale value of \$143,400. Vine also shipped a 40-foot ocean container from our facility in Louisville, TN to our distribution center in San Jose Pinula, Guatemala containing an average wholesale value of \$222,750 in aid, including medical supplies, medical equipment, fixtures, wheelchairs, & disability items.

In August, Vine shipped a 40-foot ocean container from Brunswick, GA to our distribution center in San Jose Pinula containing assorted Rx & over-the-counter drugs with an average wholesale value of \$3,178,690. In September, Vine shipped a 40-foot ocean container of wheelchairs & disability items from Ellsworth, KS to Bethel Ministries in Chimaltenango, Guatemala with an average wholesale value of \$131,020. Vine also shipped a 40-foot ocean container from Canton, OH to Hospital Shalom in San Benito, Peten, Guatemala containing an average wholesale value of \$181,300 in aid, including medical supplies, medical equipment, fixtures, wheelchairs, & disability items.

In October, Vine shipped a 40-foot ocean container from our facility in Louisville, TN to our distribution center in San Jose Pinula, Guatemala containing an average wholesale value of \$187,750 in aid, including medical supplies, medical equipment, fixtures, wheelchairs, & disability items.

One container from Boone, NC contained \$185,809 in aid of medical supplies & medical equipment. The third container from Canton, OH contained an average wholesale value of \$435,240 in aid, including medical supplies, medical equipment, fixtures, wheelchairs, & disability items. The fourth container from Brunswick, GA to our distribution center in San Jose Pinula contained assorted Rx & over-the-counter drugs with an average wholesale value of \$1,201,437.
