These records are available to be queried prior to engaging in business transactions. The Integrity Compliance Officer initially reviews all conflict of interest data. Based on this information, the officer determines what conflicts of interest exist at that point in time. Betwien times when surveys are collected Board members are expected to disclose any new conflicts that have arisen that affect pending Board decisions. As well, managers and other employees are expected to report conflicts to the Integrity Compliance Officer as they arise. Depending on the nature of the conflict and the circumstances surrounding the conflict and transaction, the Integrity Compliance Officer, Senior Leadership, or the Board of Directors may review the conflict of interest. Where appropriate these bodies may also consult legal counsel. Restrictions imposed on persons with a conflict of interest are determined on a case by case basis. For Covenant Health employees, the Integrity Compliance Officer in conjunction with Executive Leadership determines how to appropriately handle the conflict. In any conflict involving a Board member, such member is expected to excuse himself or herself from voting on matters that give rise to the conflict.
Form 990, Part VI, Section B, line 15a		Base salary for Virginia Morrow, President of Fort Sanders Foundation, SVP of Covenant Health, was established according to an executive salary structure developed by the consultant and approved by Covenant Health leadership Each salary grade has a minimum, a midpoint, and a maximum Midpoints are established by the consultant based upon contemporary market data for various positions in a tax exempt health system Initial salary offers are made by the EVP-Human Resources with review and approval by the CEO. As long as the offer is between the lower and upper levels of the mid-range of the approved salary grade, no other oversight is required. However, if the offer exceeds the mid-range, then the EVP-Human Resources in conjunction with the consultant determines reasonable compensation. Annual bonuses are determined according to the performance-based incentive compensation policy and the evaluation of the performance level of each executive. The Executive Leadership Team (comprised of the CEO, CFO, EVP-Human Resources, and EVP-Hospital operations of Covenant Health) determines each bonus award predicated on the performance of the individual on predefined, measurable annual goals. Adjustments to the salary structure and individual executive salary increases reflect information provided by the consultant. An executive's tenure, experience, and performance are also factors utilized in providing salary increases, if any. Salary increases are approved by the Executive Leadership Team.
