#### **Intent and Purpose**

The FPL Group Foundation Educational Matching Gift Program supports education by matching contributions to eligible educational institutions made by eliqible employees and directors. The program has been established to provide academic support to the educational community at the high school level and above, by matching eligible participant contributions dollar for dollar.
