The JBJ Foundation was created in April 2000 for the purpose of promoting and fostering the education of under-privileged youth. In general, the Foundation is an I Have a Dream Program sponsor.

In May 2000, the Foundation "adopted" the entire first grade class of Charles Drew Elementary School in Liberty City, Florida. Currently, 97 students known as "Dreamers" are sponsored in the program. Since the "adoption", the Foundation continues to provide various activities in furtherance of its exempt purposes of fostering the education of the students, including the following:

- Computer lab software that focuses on critical thinking, math, creative writing and language skills, and assistance in computer training and tutoring.
- After-school tutoring and programs in a small group environment including help with homework, motivational guest speakers, and various fun and team building activities.
- A comprehensive curriculum for a summer school program developed in cooperation with Miami-Dade Public Schools.
- Field trips to various community events geared toward fun, learning, awareness and new experiences.
- Parent workshops and events covering a wide range of topics in an attempt to get the parents more involved with their children and improve their lives.
- Tuition assistance for every Dreamer that gains admission to a two or four year accredited college or university as outlined specifically in the sponsorship agreement documents.
- Tutoring services for each Dreamer.

The Foundation employs two Project Coordinators that arrange for all tutoring, events, workshops, and programs.
