## AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COLORADO COALITION TO END HUNGER

Pursuant to the provisions of the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation.

### RECITALS

FIRST: The name of the corporation as originally filed with the Secretary of State's Office of the State of Colorado was COLORADO ANTI-HUNGER NETWORK. The name of the corporation has been changed to and will continue to be COLORADO COALITION TO END HUNGER (herein referred to as "the corporation").

SECOND: The corporation filed its original Articles of Incorporation on April 22, 2003.

THIRD: The following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation were adopted on the 4th day of August, 2009, in the manner prescribed by the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act, by the Board of Directors of the corporation.

The meeting of the Board of Directors was held on August 4, 2009. A quorum was present at such meeting and the amendment received at least a majority of the votes which Directors present at such meeting were entitled to cast.

FOURTH: These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation correctly set forth the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation, as amended; they have been duly adopted as required by law and they supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto.

## ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is Colorado Coalition to End Hunger.

### ARTICLE II. DURATION

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

## ARTICLE III. PURPOSES AND POWERS

Section 3.1 <u>Purposes</u>. The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Subject to the foregoing, the specific purposes and objectives of the corporation shall include but not be limited to providing charitable and educational efforts for reducing hunger.

Section 3.2 <u>Powers</u>. In furtherance of the foregoing purposes (but not otherwise) and subject to the restrictions set forth in Section 3.3, the corporation shall have and may exercise all of the powers now or hereafter conferred upon nonprofit corporations organized under the laws of the State of Colorado and may do everything necessary or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the corporate purposes, either alone or in connection with other organizations, entities or individuals, and either as principal or agent, subject to such limitations as are or may be prescribed by law.

### Section 3.3 Restrictions On Powers.

- (a) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any individual, including but not limited to its directors, officers, employees, independent contractors, or other persons of the corporation (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the benefit of the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no director or officer of the corporation or any other individual shall be entitled to share in any distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation or otherwise.
- (b) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The corporation shall not participate or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- (c) Upon dissolution of the corporation, all of the corporation's assets remaining after payment of or provision for all of its liabilities shall be paid over or transferred to one or more other exempt organizations described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, as determined by the corporation's Board of Directors.
- (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or by a corporation, contributions to which qualify as charitable contributions under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (e) All references in these Articles of Incorporation to provisions of the Internal Revenue Code are to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and to the corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

## ARTICLE IV. REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT/PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The registered office in the State of Colorado of the corporation shall be at 10700 East 45<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80239-2906, and the registered agent of the corporation upon whom process may be served is Ruth Stemler at the same address. The registered office and registered agent may be changed, without amendment of these Articles of Incorporation, as

provided by statute. The principal office of the corporation shall be 10700 East 45<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80239-2906.

### ARTICLE V. MEMBERS

The corporation shall not have members.

### ARTICLE VI. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 6.1 General. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a board of directors, except as otherwise provided in the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act, these Articles of Incorporation or the Bylaws of the corporation. The number of directors, their classifications, their terms of office and the manner of their selection shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the corporation.

Section 6.2 <u>Liability of Directors</u>. No director shall be personally liable to the corporation for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director, except that the foregoing shall not eliminate or limit liability of a director to the corporation for monetary damages for the following: (a) any breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the corporation, (b) acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law, (c) acts specified in C.R.S. Section 7-128-403, as it now exists or hereafter may be amended, or (d) any transaction from which the director directly or indirectly derived an improper personal benefit. If the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act hereafter is amended to authorize the further elimination or limitation of the liability of directors, then the liability of a director of the corporation, in addition to the limitation on personal liability provided herein, shall be further eliminated or limited to the fullest extent permitted by the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act. Any repeal or modification of this Section 6.2 shall be prospective only and shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a director of the corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.

## ARTICLE VII. BYLAWS

The Bylaws of the corporation shall be as adopted by the board of directors. Except to the extent limited by the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act, the board of directors shall have the power to alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws and adopt new Bylaws. The Bylaws of the corporation may contain any provisions for the managing and regulating of the affairs of the corporation that are not inconsistent with the law or these Articles of Incorporation, as these articles may from time to time be amended. However, no bylaw shall have the effect of giving any director or officer of the corporation or any other individual any proprietary interest in the corporation's property or assets, whether during the term of the corporation's existence or as an incident to its dissolution.

## ARTICLE VII. AMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended as provided in the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act.

## ARTICLE IX. DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution, the corporation shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of its assets as follows: (a) the assets held by the corporation in trust for specific purposes shall be applied so far as feasible in accordance with the terms of the trust; (b) the remaining assets not held in trust shall be applied so far as feasible towards carrying out the purposes stated in these Articles of Incorporation; (c) in the event and to the extent that, in the judgment of the board of directors, it is not feasible to apply the assets as provided in the foregoing clauses (a) and (b), the assets shall be applied to and for the use of such corporation organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational purposes and shall at the time qualify as an organization or organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or to the federal, state, or local government, for a public purpose, as shall be determined by the board of directors. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of in accordance with the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act and consistent with the corporation's status as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

## ARTICLE X. INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation shall indemnify every director, officer, or former director or officer of the corporation or any person who may have served at its request against expenses actually and reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with the defense of any action, suit or proceeding, civil or criminal, to which he or she is made a party by reason of his or her being or having been an officer or director of the corporation, except in relation to matters as to which he or she shall be finally adjudged in such action, suit, or proceeding to be liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of his or her duty to the corporation.
