\$250 – Grant to Lake Preston Ministerial Association to sponsor movies for the community.

\$993 – Grant to City of Miller to purchase a picnic table and support fundraising activities for purchase of additional tables for use by the community.

\$251 – Grant to Huron Area Center For Independence to rent a garden space and purchase supplies for persons with developmental disabilities to partner with the local Salvation Army and others in the community to grow produce for distribution to people in need throughout the community.

\$513 – Grant to Huron Area Center For Independence to sponsor training designed to provide law enforcement and emergency response personnel with information pertaining to persons with developmental disabilities.

\$1,681 – Grant to Huron Area Center for Independence to assist in providing financial workshop materials and babysitting to support staff serving persons with developmental disabilities to attend the training.

\$225 – Grant to assist the YWCA to offer additional activities in the after school program. The funds were used for fundraising activity expenses, rent of location, event advertisement, food, activities and supplies.

Part V Line 35

The gross revenue reported on Part I Line 6a comes from the sale of chances. This activity is not substantially related to the performance by the organization of its exempt purpose except that the organization uses the profits derived from the activity to carry out the mission of the organization. The income from this activity was not reported on Form 990-T since it occurs once a year and is not regularly carried on.
