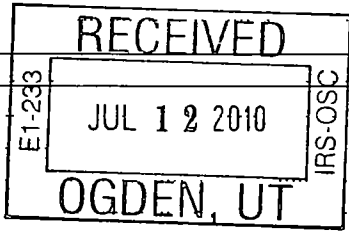

THE PROJECT CATE FOUNDATION, INC. WAS ORGANIZED IN 1997 TO DESIGN AND IMPLEMENT AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM TO TEACH CHILDREN ABOUT THEIR ENVIRONMENT, CONSERVATION, AND CAREER OPPORTUNITIES.

THE ORGANIZATION'S INITIAL ACTIVITIES WERE CONDUCTED BY THE CONSERVATION AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE OF THE MOBILE ROTARY CLUB. THAT CLUB IS ONE OF THE LARGEST AND OLDEST CIVIC ORGANIZATIONS IN MOBILE, ALABAMA, AND ITS MEMBERS REPRESENT A WIDE RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS AND INTERESTS. THE NINE DIRECTORS OF THE PROJECT CATE FOUNDATIONS, INC. ARE MEMBERS OF THE MOBILE ROTARY CLUB AND HAVE BEEN MEMBERS OF ITS CONSERVATION AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE.

THE ORGANIZATION BEGAN ITS MISSION WITH THE

DEVELOPMENT OF A WATER CONSERVATION CURRICULUM CD-ROM CALLED RIBBIT'S BIG SPLASH. THAT CD WAS COMPLETED AT A COST OF \$94,179, AND NOW 3,000 COPIES HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED FREE OF CHARGE, INCLUDING POSTAGE AND DELIVERY COSTS, TO TEACHERS AND CONSERVATION GROUPS.
