Present Bylaws of the United States Regional Association-International Association for Landscape Ecology

Established July 1986.

- ARTICLE 1. NAME. The official name of the Association will be the United States Regional Association of the International Association for Landscape Ecology.
- ARTICLE 2. PURPOSE. The purpose of the Regional Association shall be to: foster landscape ecology in the United States; provide a link between persons concerned with landscape ecology who reside in the United States and the International Association for Landscape Ecology, and other regional associations of IALE; promote interdisciplinary research and communication among scientists, planners, and other professionals concerned with landscape ecology in the United States and colleagues in other countries under the aegis of the International Association for Landscape Ecology. The Regional Association is organized solely for scientific and educational purposes.
- ARTICLE 3. ORGANIZATION AUTHORITY. The Regional Association is organized and administered according to Statutes of the International Association for Landscape Ecology, Section G, and is governed by these Statutes.
- ARTICLE 4. MEMBERSHIP. Membership is open to all persons who are engaged or concerned with the study and application of landscape ecology. Active members shall be those persons who have paid the annual dues of the association.
- ARTICLE 5. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. The officers of the Regional Association will be the President, the President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, three Councillors-at-Large, and two Student Representatives. Two Program Chairpersons and two Local Hosts, one each for the present year's and the following year's annual meeting, will be ex-officio (non-voting) members of the Executive Committee (see Article 8). The officers shall be representative of the diverse disciplines and professions that are concerned with landscape ecology. The Executive Committee shall conduct such business of the Regional Association as shall be necessary and appropriate between the business meetings of the Regional Association. Members of the Executive Committee shall be elected by majority vote on a ballot distributed by the Secretary to all members using either postal or electronic means. Only student members may vote for the Student Representatives. The term of office for the President-Elect shall be one year, with the President-Elect then serving the following two years as President. The term of office for all other officers shall be two years. Any officer may be re-elected.

ARTICLE 6. DUTIES OF PRESIDENT. The President shall convene and chair meetings of the Executive Committee, preside at business meetings of the Regional Association, and represent the Regional Association on the IALE Council, as specified in Section G1 of the IALE Statutes. The President's term of office shall begin in even-numbered years.

ARTICLE 7. DUTIES OF THE PRESIDENT-ELECT. The President-Elect shall attend all Executive Committee meetings and gain thorough familiarity with the organization and current activities of the Regional Association and IALE. As assigned by the President, the President-Elect will fulfill other duties designed to prepare the President-Elect for leadership of the Regional Association. In the absence of the President, the President-Elect shall preside over Executive Committee meetings and represent the Regional Association on the IALE Council, as specified in Section G1 of the IALE Statutes. The President-Elect's term of office shall begin in odd-numbered years, with service in this position during the second year in office of the current President.

ARTICLE 8. DUTIES OF PROGRAM CHAIRPERSON AND LOCAL HOST. The Program Chairperson and Local Host shall be selected and approved by the Executive Committee They shall develop programs and make local arrangements for annual meetings, together with a possible professional meeting planner. The Chair of the Meeting Site Selection Committee serves as the liaison among Program Chair, Local Host, a possible professional meeting planner, and the Executive Committee. In case there are disagreements over meeting arrangements (e.g., registration fees), the Executive Committee makes the final decisions. At any given time, there will be a Program Chair and a Local Host responsible for the present year's and second Chair and Host for the next year's annual meetings.

ARTICLE 9. DUTIES OF SECRETARY. The Secretary shall keep the membership records of the Regional Association, notify members of meetings, maintain the minutes of annual meetings and meetings of the Executive Committee, collate news items for the Regional Bulletin and mail copies of the IALE BULLETIN to members of the Regional Association. The Secretary's term of office shall begin in even-numbered years.

ARTICLE 10. DUTIES OF TREASURER. The Treasurer shall send notices of membership dues, receive membership dues from the members of the Regional Association, manage the budget and maintain the financial records of the Regional Association, submit the annual payment to the International Secretariat as stipulated in Statutes of IALE, Article L2, provide a financial statement to the Executive Committee periodically, and to the membership at the annual meeting, or in the IALE Bulletin, as appropriate, and mail reminders of overdue membership dues. The Treasurer shall authorize expenditure of funds from the Regional Association's account on behalf of the Executive Committee. The Treasurer's term of office shall begin in odd-numbered years.

ARTICLE 11. COUNCILLORS-AT-LARGE. US-IALE shall strive to ensure that each Councillor-at-Large represents a different discipline or profession. A Councillor-at-Large shall perform such duties as may from time to time be assigned to him/her by the

President, and shall be appointed by the President to fulfill the duties of another officer who is unable to complete his/her term of office. Two Councillors-at-Large shall be elected in even-numbered years, and one in odd-numbered years.

ARTICLE 12. STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES. The Student Representatives will be primarily responsible for fostering communication and interaction of U.S. - IALE students both among themselves and the greater membership of U.S. - IALE. Student representatives will serve as contact points for students, represent student concerns, promote student membership, and solicit nominations and oversee the election of successors. Student representatives may also assist local host and program chair with student-related meeting arrangements, and arrange workshops or symposia oriented towards students. One student representative will be elected each year for a two-year term. Thus, at any given time, there will be a continuing student representative and a student representative 'elect' serving on the committee.

ARTICLE 13. MEETINGS. The business meeting of the Regional Association shall be held once each year. Ordinarily, this meeting shall be held concurrently with an annual meeting cosponsored by the Regional Association and a host institution. Alternatively, the annual meeting may be held in conjunction with meetings of an appropriate professional association as specified by the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE 14. MEMBERSHIP FEES. The membership fee will be established annually by the Executive Committee. It shall be used to defray the costs of the Regional Association, and to provide financial support to the International Secretariat, as specified in the Statutes of IALE, Section L. Membership shall lapse when a person is one year in arrears in annual dues, payment being due on January 1 of each year.

ARTICLE 15. PUBLICATIONS. The publication of the Regional Association shall be the US-IALE Newsletter which, along with the IALE BULLETIN, shall be distributed semi-annually in June and December to all current members of the Regional Association.

ARTICLE 16. US-IALE AWARDS COMMITTEE. To recognize outstanding contributions from members of the landscape ecology community, the society shall present awards in the following categories: Best Student Presentation at the annual meeting (whereas both oral and poster presentations are considered); Distinguished Landscape Ecologist; Distinguished Landscape Practitioner; Distinguished Service to US-IALE; and Best Publication in Landscape Ecology. The Best Student Presentation shall be awarded on an annual basis; the competition shall be organized and implemented by the committee. Judges shall be solicited from those individuals attending the annual meeting. The Best Student Presentation awards(s) to be given will be based on results of judging for that year. Nominations for the three Distinguished awards and the Best Publication in Landscape Ecology award shall be solicited from the membership and not all awards must be given/awarded in a given year, at the discretion of the Awards Committee and their review of eligible nominations against the award criteria. The committee shall present the awards during the annual meeting. The Awards Committee shall consist of five to seven members appointed by the President of US-IALE.

ARTICLE 17. FOREIGN SCHOLAR TRAVEL AWARD COMMITTEE. In recognition that international perspectives are valuable to members of US-IALE, the Foreign Scholar Travel Award is established to support travel to our annual meetings for foreign colleagues. The annual awardee will be selected by the Foreign Scholar Travel Award Committee, the Chair of which will be appointed by the President of US-IALE. The committee will be composed of three to seven US-IALE members, selected by the Foreign Scholar Travel Award Committee Chair and the President of US-IALE. The abstract of a successful applicant must be accepted by the Program Committee and has high scientific value. Preference will be given to candidates from countries with which contact is generally more difficult and with greater financial need. The award amount will be set by the US-IALE Executive Committee.

ARTICLE 18. MEETING SITE SELECTION COMMITTEE. The Site Selection Committee works on a four-year time horizon to target future meeting hosts and locations. This committee also is responsible for fostering a long-term memory on meeting planning and updating this document, as appropriate. The President appoints a Councillor-at-large as the Committee Chair and includes 3-4 other individuals as committee members. The Committee Chair also serves a liaison among the Program Chair, Local Host, a possible professional meeting planner, and the Executive Committee to foster communication and avoid any delay in meeting planning.

ARTICLE 19. SPONSORSHIP COMMITTEE. The Sponsorship Committee seeks to increase revenue for the annual conference by obtaining sponsorship from a wide variety of organizations such as government agencies, companies, and educational institutions that support landscape ecology and, thereby, lower the registration fees associated with the annual meeting. The main duties of the Committee are to contact and recruit possible sponsors for the annual US-IALE conferences, and develop and maintain a database of possible sponsors. The President will appoint the Committee Chair and 4-6 other people as committee members.

ARTICLE 20. NOMINATING COMMITTEE. A Nominating Committee (with 1 Chair and 4 members), appointed by the President, is responsible for seeking nominations from the membership and preparing a balanced slate of candidates for President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, and Councillors-at-large. The Committee shall also count the votes and announce the voting results.

ARTICLE 21. AMENDMENTS. These by-laws may be amended by a two-thirds majority vote of either 1) those members voting at any annual meeting, or 2) those returning a ballot distributed by the Secretary to all current members by either postal or electronic means. Text of proposed amendments shall be published in the Regional Bulletin and/or distributed by postal service or electronically to current members at least sixty (60) days prior to the voting deadline.
