CHILDREN'S ARTS NETWORK

The Norman Children's Chorus is a program of Children's Arts Network, a non-profit organization designed to provide excellent arts experiences for children. Now in its seventh year, NCC is open to all eight through fourteen year old students with unchanged voices. The mission of the chorus is to provide children with the opportunity to sing quality choral music in a community setting; to further the children's vocal development and their musicianship skills; and to provide the community with the opportunity to hear a variety of traditional and contemporary choral music sung by children. The NCC has participated in exchange concerts with children's choruses from Tulsa, Shawnee and Stillwater. Special honors have included singing at the 1996 Oklahoma Music Educators Association as the honor performing group, performances with Canterbury Choral Society and Cimarron Circuit Opera and a residency with Nick Page. Enrollment is now open for the fall semester.

Artworks, another program of Children's Arts Network, is a summer arts day camp for children aged 8 - 12. Two three-week sessions are held and the children attend from 9:00 - 4:00 every weekday. Now in its ~~twelfth~~^{seventh} year, Artworks takes place at Stage Center in Oklahoma City. Extended hours supervision is available to accommodate working parents. Participants study dance, theatre, visual arts and music in addition to participating in field trips and working with guest artists. Artworks is designed to provide opportunities for personal growth, sharing creativity, social interaction, skill development and presentation of work in an atmosphere of culture, fun and relaxation. Enrollment is open for the summer sessions.

Norman Children's Choral Festival is a summer chorus day camp that takes place the first week of June at Whittier Middle School. Hours are 9:00 AM to 12 noon, Tuesday through Friday. A final concert is presented at noon on Friday. Enrollment is open to all children aged 8 - 14 with unchanged voices who like to sing. Students will participate in rehearsals, instrument technique, creative movement and composition. Enrollment is now open.

These programs are funded in part by the Norman Arts and Humanities Council and the Oklahoma Arts Council. For information call (405) 329-0170.
