Part XV Purpose of Grants or Contributions

Boys and Girls Club of the Virginia Peninsula provides cultural, educational, and recreational activities to help youth overcome obstacles and achieve success. The organization emphasizes character development and responsible citizenship and is presented in a manner that is engaging and fun. There are a variety of sports and after school programs that provide supervision and safe places to learn and grow and develop ongoing relationships with caring, adult professionals.

Cleveland Coutny CASA, Inc. is a court appointed non-profit advocacy group serving Cleveland, Garvin and McClain counties. CASA speaks up for children who have been abused or neglected and need a voice in the child welfare system. CASA's community volunteers are trained court advocates who give a voice to children who have no one to represent their best interests.

Eden Clinic (Formerly Care Net) Provides Pregnancy testing, counseling, education, and material assistance. Counseling includes education on the three options for an unexpected pregnancy. Education includes pregnancy, childbirth, parenting. Ultrasound equipment is available for expecting mothers to get to know their baby prior to its birth. Material Assistance includes baby clothing, diapers, baby accessories and baby furniture which young women earn participation in educational programs of their choice. Referrals to other agencies are made as needed.

Deliverance Ministries, Inc. is a non-profit, non-denominational, volunteer-reliant ministry providing group education and individual counseling and prayer with a focus on deliverance and inner healing. The program stresses that deliverance is not a one time quick fix, but rather an important part of identifying issues and equipping people with methods and tools to gain freedom from harmful strongholds that are hindering their lives.

Food and Shelter for Friends of Norman Oklahoma provides hot daily meals for needy people and temporary shelter for homeless families in transition and counseling to encourage employment and resolving other problems of the homeless.

Journey Church - VBX (Vacation Bible School) and Children's New Theme Project. Vacation Bible school is an annual week long day school open to all children of Norman and surrounding communities and includes arts, crafts, songs and games with stories and teaching for children. The "All In" Initiative is for the new East Campus facility with its emphasis on an after school program for children from nearby Kennedy school.

McFarlin United Methodist Church - Communion Fund assists people in financial crisis to pay for essential expenses such as utility bills. Also includes a food pantry for the needy.

Norman Regional Health Foundation (NRHF)- was created to accept, invest, and distribute private gifts in support of the its mission which is to provide quality and compassionate healthcare services and education to the regional community. Services include the Healthy Community blood pressure stations, the Mammogram Initiative which distributes information packets on breast cancer prevention, the installation of smoke alarms in awarded through Fire Prevention and Safety program of FEMA. NRHF also supports the Healthy Youth program which includes screening more than 12,000 children at local elementary schools, plus Healthcare scholarships and influenza vaccinations through the annual Drive Thru Flu Shot Clinic.

Oklahoma United Methodist Circle of Care is a Methodist-based agency whose mission is to provide help, healing and wholeness to children, youth and families who are hurting by helping people make better choices, live happier lives, and find hope and promise in their futures. COC combines Christian influence with a therapeutic continuum of professional services. COC's residential group homes include the United Methodist Boy's Ranch in Gore, Frances E. Willard Home for Girls in Tulsa, and the United Methodist Children's Home in Tahlequah. Foster care through Child Share helps place children in homes through local church congregations and provides care for the changing physical, emotional and spiritual needs of individuals.

Oklahoma Jail-Prison Fellowship is a non-profit, volunteer-reliant ministry ministering directly to jail and prison inmates through counseling and Bible study. Thousands of prisoners are touched every year by OJPF with nearly 2,000 professions of faith annually. OJPF is currently exploring a means of partnering with local churches to offer follow-up support for individuals once they are released.

WildCare Foundation provides medical care for injured wild animals and eventually frees them back into their natural habitat.
