The salary levels are based on compensation surveys and other data from the Colorado Nonprofit Association, as well as the compensation levels at other similarly-situated organizations. This information, along with the annual performance appraisal, is presented to the Executive Committee for review and approval. The Executive Committee maintains the necessary documentation regarding the compensation setting process in its minutes.
