In 2009, 37 retreats were held with over 1,750 guests attending. Nationally known speakers and resource people from across the country were brought in to help ensure the excellence of these retreats. Financial assistance of \$14,395 allowed individuals and couples in need to attend retreats. Financial assistance from the Laity Lodge Speakers' Fund covered 71% of speaker honorariums.**4b** (Code _____) (Expenses \$ 146,667, including grants of \$ 0.) (Revenue \$ 0.)Grants to support affiliated organizations in furtherance of mutual visions around the renewal and transformation of daily life. Grant to Laity Lodge Foundation allowed 115 youth ages 7-16 to attend a one-week or two-week camp session at a discount or free of charge based on financial need. Grants to the H. E. Butt Foundation Free Camp program provided funding that assisted in the operation of facilities that were used by over 250 nonprofit groups, representing over 22,000 people, at no charge. The Free Camp program especially targets youth in Texas communities who would not otherwise be able to afford such an experience. Funds were also granted to H. E. Butt Foundation to improve technology innovations and build stronger websites that help strengthen faith in the
