The mission of CTCF is to enhance the quality of life in the local area CTCF carries out this very broad mission by building restricted funds and using the annual income to support a variety of local nonprofit organizations through grants and special projects. CTCF's assets are held in separate funds established by local individuals, families, businesses, and charitable institutions. Each fund may have a special purpose, but the foundation board of directors, representing the community, oversees them all. The IRS recognizes CTCF as a public charity in part because they receive support from the general public and their board broadly represents the area served.
