Funds an individual receives from the Foundation in excess of the amount spent for permissible uses shall be returned to the Foundation (or applied against future awards to that individual). Reports describing the expenditure of grant or scholarship funds are to be submitted to the Foundation within one (1) month after the completion of each semester or trimester of study. Such report shall be a written report including a financial accounting for the entire amount of the scholarship or grant, information on whether the recipient is *maintaining* satisfactory academic progress (to include a copy of grade reports for each semester or trimester for which scholarship or grant funds were received)) and such other information as the Foundation may reasonably require.

An "Approved School" is an educational organization that normally maintains a regular facility and curriculum and normally has a regularly enrolled body of pupils or students in attendance at the place where its educational activities are regularly carried on, within the meaning of Section 197 (b) (1) (A) (ii) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, other than an organization that the Board has provided, by resolution, shall not be an Approved School.
