During 1995 and 1996, the Trust provided an aggregate of \$2,000,000.00 of the cost of completing the projects. The hospice inpatient facility located in Wichita Falls, Texas is owned and operated by Hospice of Wichita Falls, Inc., a tax exempt organization for those times when patients have pain or other symptoms that can not be controlled at home. During 2009 the Trust provided \$87,865.86 to Hospice of Wichita Falls, Inc for repairs to, and capital improvements of the inpatient facility and administrative offices.
