The Foundation currently sponsors scholarships to students at the Weiser High School in Weiser, Idaho. In order to be considered for a scholarship award, students must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale), have a grade point average during their first semester or first two trimesters of their senior year in high school of at least 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale), and have achieved an overall ACT score of at least 20 or an overall SAT score of at least 1000. Students must not be a family member of any officer, director or manager of the Foundation or of any person serving on any selection committee. Scholarship applicant must provide evidence of eligibility under the above criteria and submit a statement of his or her background and life experiences, including information regarding his or her qualities of leadership and character, as evidenced by awards received, achievements accomplished, school, community or church service, and participation in school sports, activities and events. Applicants must also provide letters of recommendation from his or her high school guidance counselor, two high school teachers and a church or community leader (unrelated to the student), and a personal statement of goals and ambitions. Applicants must also demonstrate financial need through a disclosure of income and resources available for his or her higher education including any other scholarships or financial awards received. Scholarship applications are available at the high school, and all applications will be screened by a selection committee consisting of teachers and counselors at the high school. The Foundation will annually provide the high school selection committee with an indication of the amount of financial aid to be granted by the Foundation. Based on the amount of available financial aid, the selection committee will narrow the list of candidates to approximately two or three individuals per available scholarship. The Foundation managers will then select the scholarship recipients based on the above criteria.
