XIV. SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

During 2009, the Organization implemented Financial Accounting Standards Board Interpretation No. (FIN) 48, Accounting for Uncertainty in Income Taxes. Management evaluates the Organization's tax positions annually for any potential changes or issues that may result in uncertainty in the accounting for income taxes.

As of December 31, 2009, management believes the Organization's tax status to be that of a not-for-profit entity and therefore has made the decision to classify the Organization as tax exempt. The Organization has filed all required tax returns in the required jurisdictions in a timely manner. Management has reviewed all sources of revenue and does not believe the Organization to be subject to income tax on unrelated business income. The Organization did not record any interest or penalties in the statement of operations or statement of financial position as of and during the year ended December 31, 2009. Tax returns filed for the years ended December 31, 2006 through 2008 remain subject to examination by the Internal Revenue Service.
