A. Background and Organization:

The York Children's Foundation (the "Foundation") was organized by the York Group, Inc. ("York"), as a nonprofit Texas corporation. The Foundation was created for the purpose of providing financial support to nonprofit organizations and programs engaged primarily in benefiting the health, education and welfare of children.

The Foundation has been determined to be a charitable private foundation by the Internal Revenue Service. Substantially all of the Foundation's support is provided by York and the independent distributors of its products. All awards and grants are determined by the Foundation's board of trustees. A majority of the board of trustees is comprised of persons who are not directly affiliated with York or its independent distributors.

In December 2001, York was acquired by Matthews International Corporation ("Matthews") however, the Foundation is still administrated by the board of trustees.

B. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies:

Accrual Basis

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

Basis of Presentation

Information with respect to the Foundation's financial position and activities is presented according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets and permanently restricted net assets.

A description of these categories follows:

Unrestricted Net Assets

Include the net assets that are free of donor-imposed restrictions and are neither permanently restricted nor temporarily restricted.

Temporarily Restricted Net Assets

Include the net assets from contributions or other inflows where the use is limited by donor-imposed restrictions that either expire by the passage of time or can be fulfilled and removed by actions of the organization. At December 31, 2009, there were no net assets temporarily restricted.

Permanently Restricted Net Assets

Include the net assets from contributions or other inflows where the use is limited by donor-imposed restrictions that neither expire by passage of time nor can be fulfilled or removed by actions of the organization. At December 31, 2009, there were no assets permanently restricted.

B. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies (cont.):

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Contributions

York and the independent distributors of its products make contributions to the Foundation based upon the products sold and registered with the Foundation. The Foundation also receives unsolicited contributions and memorial donations from York, the independent distributors and outside parties. The Foundation adheres to Statement of Financial Accounting Standards ("SFAS") No. 116, *Accounting for Contributions Received and Contributions Made*. In accordance with SFAS No. 116, contributions received are recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted support, depending on the existence and/or nature of any donor restrictions. (See Basis of Presentation).

Grants to Other Organizations

The Foundation makes contributions to not-for-profit organizations and programs engaged in benefiting the health, education and welfare of children. The Foundation recognizes the expense in the period in which the board of trustees approves the distributions of grants and the Foundation makes the distributions.

Administrative Expenses

Certain administrative expenses of the Foundation, including, but not limited to, registration fees, registration card processing and marketing expenditures, are paid by York on behalf of the Foundation. Other expenses, such as professional fees, are paid by the Foundation.

Income Taxes

The Foundation has received a determination letter, dated April 21, 1992, from the Internal Revenue Service stating that the Foundation is exempt from Federal income taxes under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Accordingly, no provision for income taxes has been made in the accompanying financial statements.

Cash Equivalents

The Foundation considers all highly liquid investments with an original maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents. These investments are carried at cost which approximates market.

Investment Income

Investment income consists of interest income on cash and cash equivalents.

C. Donated Services:

The day-to-day operations of the Foundation are performed by employees of York. No amounts for these services have been reflected in the accompanying financial statements for these services.

D. Net Assets:

The Foundation's classes of members consists of those who own voting stock and those who own sponsoring stock. All of the voting stock is owned by York. The sponsoring stock is owned by independent distributors of York. The sponsoring stock is nonvoting. Neither class of members has a residual interest in the stock.

The members' initial contribution balance has been reflected in the Foundation's net assets as of December 31, 2009.


