BYLAWS OF GlobeMed

ARTICLE I — NAME AND PURPOSE

Section 1 - Name: The name of the organization shall be **GlobeMed**. It shall be a nonprofit organization incorporated under the laws of the State of Illinois.

Section 2 — Purpose: **GlobeMed** is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific and education purposes.

The purpose of this corporation is:

- to improve the health of the impoverished by partnering student-led chapters with grassroots health organizations in the developing world;
- to raise funds to support public health projects at partner;
 organizations-that-benefit-the-health-of-the-impoverished;
- to train and inspire students to become devoted to a life of leadership for global health and social justice;
- to build a movement for global health equity.

ARTICLE II - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 — Membership: Membership shall consist of the board of directors.

ARTICLE III — BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1 — Board role, size, and compensation: The board is responsible for overall policy and direction of the organization, and delegates responsibility of day-to-day operations to the staff. **The board shall have up to 15 members.** The board receives no compensation other than reasonable expenses.

Section 2 — Terms: All board members shall serve three-year terms, and are eligible for re-election for a maximum of three consecutive terms.

Section 3 — Meetings and notice: The board shall meet at least quarterly, at an agreed upon time and place. An official board meeting requires that each board member have written notice at least two weeks in advance.

Section 4 — Board elections: During the last quarter of each fiscal year of the corporation, the board of directors shall elect Directors to replace those whose terms will expire at the end of the fiscal year. This election shall take place during a regular meeting of the directors, called in accordance with the provisions of these bylaws.

Section 5 — Election procedures: New directors shall be elected by a majority of directors present at such a meeting, provided there is a quorum present. Directors so elected shall serve a term beginning on the first day of the next fiscal year.

Section 6 — Quorum: A quorum must be attended by at least fifty percent of board members for business transactions to take place and motions to pass.

Section 7 — Officers and Duties: There shall be three officers of the board, consisting of a chair, secretary and treasurer. During the last quarter officiers shall be elected by the majority of the board. Terms shall be for one year and renewable.

Their duties are as follows:

The chair shall convene regularly scheduled board meetings and preside or arrange for other members of the board to preside at each meeting, send out meeting announcements and distribute copies of minutes and the agenda to each board member.

The secretary shall be responsible for keeping records of board actions, including overseeing the taking of minutes at all board meetings, and assuring that corporate records are maintained.

The treasurer shall make a report at each board meeting. The treasurer shall chair the finance committee, assist in the preparation of the budget, and make financial information available to board members and the public.

Section 8 — Vacancies: When a vacancy on the board exists mid-term, the secretary must receive nominations for new members from present board members two weeks in advance of a board meeting. These nominations shall be sent out to board members with the regular board meeting announcement, to be voted upon at the next board meeting. These vacancies will be filled only to the end of the particular board member's term.

Section 9 — Resignation, termination, and absences: Resignation from the board must be in writing and received by the secretary. A board member may be removed by a two-third vote of the remaining directors.

Section 10 — Special meetings: Special meetings of the board shall be called upon the request of the chair, or one-third of the board. Notices of special meetings shall be sent out by the secretary to each board member at least two weeks in advance.

ARTICLE IV - COMMITTEES

Section 1 — Committee formation: The board may create committees as needed. The board Chair appoints all committee chairs.

ARTICLE V - DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Section 1 — Executive Director: The executive director is hired by the board. The executive director has day-to-day responsibilities for the organization, including carrying out the organization's goals and policies. The executive director will attend all board meetings, report on the progress of the organization, answer questions of the board members and carry out the duties described in the job description. The board can designate other duties as necessary.

ARTICLE VI — AMENDMENTS

Section 1 — Amendments: These bylaws may be amended when necessary by a majority of the board of directors. Proposed amendments must be submitted to the secretary to be sent out with regular board announcements.
