We will then be in contact with the patient to obtain financial aid. When a patient is pre-registered in person and they are private pay, we refer them to MECS for help to obtain Medicaid or Medicare, if eligible. If the patient does not qualify for any other programs, they are then referred to financial assistance. If we pre-register the patient over the phone, we finish the pre-registration and then transfer the call to MECS for screening. Then they are referred to Financial Aid, if needed
