Any uninsured individual with income under 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG) will be eligible to receive a discount from charges based on certain guidelines. Completion of the Financial Assistance application and proof of Medicaid denial will be required. In some cases, full or partial assistance may be provided to insured individuals with gross family incomes above 250% of the FPG adjusted for family size. Catastrophic Financial Assistance is available to individuals who have a large balance remaining after all third party payments have been taken into account. The balance under consideration is that amount which is deemed to be the patient's financial responsibility. If such responsibility is greater than 50% of the family's annual household income, the excess amount will be treated as Catastrophic Financial Assistance and written off of the patient's account. This assistance is available without respect to the FPG, but they must follow the same process as all other patients seeking financial assistance based upon FPG. Asset tests are not used for determining any level of financial assistance. All decisions regarding financial assistance are in the sole discretion of BDH. Prior to receiving services, BDH will make an effort to notify the patient regarding their eligibility for financial assistance.

Part I, Line 7g The Hospital continues providing the following Care Programs due to the importance of providing such quality care to the community, despite overall costs being significantly higher than could be realized from charges, thus the Hospital subsidizes these health services to ensure the quality of care provided remains exemplary. Renal Dialysis Services, Internal Medicine Associates, Hathaway Internal Medicine, Bridger Internal Medicine, Bozeman Deaconess Women's Services, Neurology, Diabetes Clinic, Bozeman Urology, Medical Associates, Gastroenterology Clinic, Cardio Pulmonary Rehabilitiation, Anti-Coagulant Clinic, Clinical Nutrition Services, Hospice, and Palliative Care

Part I, Line 7f The amount of bad debt expense removed from the denominator is \$11,557,634

Part I, Line 7 Amount of cost attributable to a physician clinic is \$19,705,343 The cost to charge ratio was used to obtain the costs related to Charity Care, Medicaid, and Other Means-Tested Programs Worksheet 2, Ratio of Patient Care Cost to Charges was used in determining this ratio. All Other Benefits were calculated using our internal costing system. This system assigns all direct expenses to separate cost centers (departments) and accounts. Indirect costs are then allocated to applicable departments based on appropriate statistics. For example, Engineering and Environmental services would be allocated based on square footage whereas Information Systems and Benefits are allocated based on an accumulated cost percentage as determined by the Medicare Cost Report. Our internal system does record patient revenues based on type (inpatient vs. outpatient vs. emergency) and payor (Medicaid, Medicare, Commercial, Self-Pay, etc.) Related costs are then determined based on the pro-rated share as a percentage of the total. For example, if Medicaid comprises 7% of a departments revenue, Medicaid expenses are calculated at 7% of the total as well

Part III, Line 4 Per footnote 1 of Audited Financials "Management considers historical write off and recovery information in determining the estimated bad debt provision" The expense for such provision is included in operating expenses within the audited financials. The organization uses Worksheet 2 to calculate bad debt expense at cost. Bad debt is reported based upon actual bad debt expense net of discounts and contractual adjustments, less recoveries. In determining the amount of bad debt attributable to patients eligible under our charity care policy, we obtained statistical information directly from our credit agencies. From this information we were able to calculate an average percentage (7.8%) of accounts turned over for collections that were subsequently deemed uncollectible or returned for charity. The organization uses. Worksheet 2 to calculate bad debt expense at cost. This percentage was applied to bad debt expense at cost to determine the estimate.

Part III, Line 8 The entire amount of shortfall should be considered a community benefit The Medicare shortfall represents a cost absorbed by the Hospital as a result of providing care to Medicare patients. The contract driving this loss is a nondiscretionary contract, as is providing the services to this population of individuals. The cost of providing this benefit to the community should be reportable as such Total Medicare Allowable Costs were obtained from the Medicare Cost Report (worksheet D-1, total program excludable cost plus total program inpatient operating cost in addition to outpatient costs in worksheet D, part V, total for PPS Services). The Medicare allowable costs backed on in line 2 are those costs originally included in line 1 that are attributable to Subsidized Services.

- 2 Needs assessment. Describe how the organization assesses the health care needs of the communities it serves
- Part VI, Line 2 Bozeman Deaconess conducts a health care needs assessment once every two years, the most recent being completed in 2009. The preliminary steps to performing this assessment involve gathering information about the consumer and the community assets. This includes economic and demographic profiles, birth and death characteristics, disease incidence and prevalence, health status and behaviors, health care utilization, social and community issues, and school and student population characteristics. We also review local associations, local institutions and their resources, community health resources, and physical assets of the community. Using this data, we determine the scope of the assessment and issues to be addressed. Survey questions are then developed and the survey is administered to two populations: a general household mail survey (random sample of 2,550 Gallatin County Households) and a self-selected 'convenience' survey (surveys left and collected at selected locations.) Upon receiving the results, Senior Administration and the Board develop priorities and set forth a course of action.
- 3 Patient education of eligibility for assistance. Describe how the organization informs and educates patients and persons who may be billed for patient care about their eligibility for assistance under federal, state, or local government programs or under the organization's charity care policy

Part VI, Line 3 Bozeman Deaconess Hospital is deeply committed to providing financial assistance to patients needing, but unable to afford, medically necessary health care services BDH posts notice of its Financial Assistance Policy in all admitting areas, as well as on the website. At the earliest feasible time, BDH will attempt to determine whether a patient has third party coverage for any part of the hospital services provided. If a patient does not have third party coverage, a patient advocate from the MASH program will screen all inpatients cases and any outpatient cases exceeding \$1,000 in total charges to determine if the patient qualifies for third party funding. If not, the patient advocate will explain the Financial Assistance Policy and give the patient an application if desired. In circumstances where payment in full will cause financial hardship that will significantly harm the patient or patient's family, the applicant may be asked to visit with Consumer Credit Counseling Services to further review the financial situations. Upon request, patients may be asked to complete an application for Medicaid participation or for coverage by other governmental payment programs. Patient bills also contain billing information explaining financial options and provide contact information to the appropriate resources.

- Part VI, Line 4 Our 'community' is defined as Gallatin, Park and Madison Counties. Considered a rural area, estimated 2009 populations were 91,710, 16,275, and 7,633, respectively. The estimated average household incomes were \$67,000, \$55,000, and \$57,000, respectively. Approximately 72% of households had an income of less than \$50,000, with 10.5% being less than \$15,000. The average household size is just over 2 and the federal poverty guideline for a family of 2 is approx \$15,000. For Gallatin County, 16% of the population's health care costs were covered by a government payor, in Park and Madison Counties governmental payors support about 27% of the populations. Respectively, 5%, 8%, and 5% of these pools are for Medicaid. Approximately 24% of Gallatin County was without health insurance. Bozeman Deaconess Hospital is the only local hospital in these 3 counties, while there is 1 critical access hospital in Park County and 2 in Madison County. All of Park County is considered a medically underserved area, as is a portion of Madison County.
