Part V, Line 4	Description of Intended Use of Endowment Funds	St John's Foundation has established endowment funds whose earnings will provide an income stream to support the mission of St John's for years to come The St John's Foundation's Board of Directors is responsible for approving expenditures from these endowment funds Until 2006, all earnings of the endowment funds had been reinvested to help the funds grow When the St John's Living Endowment grew greater than \$1,000,000, the Foundation's Board of Directors approved to use up to \$35,000 of the interest earnings to support residents of St John's who had run out of resources. This allowed them to remain at St John's in the environment that would allow them to flourish Endowment for Spiritual Care - to support Chaplaincy at St John's and to help ensure that St John's will continue to be a spiritual home for our residents and staff. Sulenes Endowment for Alzheimer's Care, established in 2005 with a \$100,000 gift, the Norman L and Mary Lou Sulenes Endowment for Alzheimer's Care will support those affected by Alzheimer's or dementia and the staff who care for them. In 2006, a \$150,000 contribution was made to this endowment fund. In 2007, a \$50,000 gift was provided by a St John's resident. This same resident contributed \$75,000 and \$50,000 to this endowment in 2009 and 2008, respectively. St John's Living Endowment - Proceeds from this endowment fund are not earmarked for a specific purpose at St John's, but will be used to support needs identified within the community. At this time, interest earnings are earmarked to support residents who live at St John's who can no longer afford to live here. Kathy Lillis Chapel Endowment - Established with a gift from the Campus Chapel Foundation and Fellowship, this fund was established to maintain the Kathy Lillis Chapel. The Ralph Nelles Education Endowment was established in 2009 with a \$135,000 gift from the estate of noted Billings artist Hall Diteman.
