In connection with the preparation of the accounting for the preparation of Form 990-PF for 2010, it was discovered that some ordinary income and capital gains earned by, but not received from, a Passive Foreign Investment Company (PFIC) was inadvertently reported as income on the return, as originally filed. It was discovered that distributions received from other Passive Foreign Investment Companies, which should have been reported as sales, was also inadvertently omitted from the return as originally filed. It was also discovered that in kind donations of occupancy and services provided to another non profit entity was inadvertently omitted from the return as originally filed.

The net effect of these amendments is to reduce the Excise tax and increase the total overpayment by \$2,177. Since the overpayment of \$18,521,as originally reported, has been credited to 2010 estimated tax, this amended return requests a refund of the additional overpayment in the amount of \$2,177. Additional schedules explaining the required changes are attached.
