As a service to the patient, the Medical Center bills third-party payers directly and bills the patient when the patient's liability is determined. Patient accounts receivable are due in full when billed. Accounts are considered delinquent and subsequently written off as bad debts based on individual credit evaluation and specific circumstances of the account. Our costing methodology used to determine bad debt expense uses a ratio of patient care costs to charges.

Article IV The Board Changes were made in Section 4.04 to clarify the Board Selection Task Force procedures for the selection of the members of the board of directors. For the benefit of the members of the board of directors, a Standard of Care was added as Section 4.06. This provision is intended to provide guidance to the board of directors as to the duties of the members.
