Volunteer Grants

Matching Grants

Volunteer Grants turn your volunteer hours into cash. As an employee or retiree you can request a contribution of up to \$500 a year on behalf of an area non-profit organization with which you volunteer.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

To receive a Volunteer Grant:

- Volunteer on your own time, outside of work hours, to a qualifying 501(c)3 organization in New Mexico, Texas or a community where an employee of PNM Resources lives. You must not receive pay or any other form of compensation from the non-profit organization for your service.
- Contribute a minimum of 12 hours for a \$100 donation, 25 hours for a \$200 donation or 25 hours plus service on the board of directors for a \$500 donation.
- Employees and retirees may request only one Volunteer Grant of either \$100, \$200 or \$500 in each calendar year.

When you support charitable, civic and educational organizations, the PNM Resources Foundation will match your donation. Matching Grants double your contributions to qualifying organizations.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

To receive a Matching Grant:

- Monetary contribution must come from an individual; corporate gifts do not qualify.
- Monetary contribution must be made to a nonprofit in New Mexico, Texas or a community where an employee of PNM Resources lives or to any accredited educational institution nationwide.
- Contributions must be in the form of cash or marketable securities. Gifts in-kind, dues, membership fees and pledges will not be matched.
- Contributions will be matched in an amount not less than \$25 and not more than \$1,000, in the aggregate, in a calendar year.

Matching Grants and Volunteer Grants are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis from a pool of funds established annually by the Foundation Board of Trustees. The Foundation reserves the right to suspend, amend or terminate the grants programs at any time without notice.
