- 3) The application must be submitted to Columbus Electric Cooperative, Inc., P. O. Box 631, Deming, New Mexico 88031, by June 30 to be eligible for assistance in the Fall semester of any school year, and by December 31 to be eligible for assistance in the Spring semester of any school year.
- 4) The grant shall be in the amount of \$250.00 per student per semester. The number of grants issued each year will be determined by the Trustees.
- 5) Academic accomplishments, character and need will be the determining factors in selecting the persons to receive these education grants.
- 6) Should the student be selected for the grant, the grant will be made available upon proof of registration for the first semester.
