THE PRIMARY EXEMPT PURPOSE OF THE NEW MEXICO HUNTER JUMPER ASSOCIATION (NMHJA) IS TO PROMOTE AND STANDARDIZE LICENSED HUNTER JUMPER COMPETITIONS AND OTHER EQUESTRIAN ACTIVITIES IN THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO. THE NMHJA IS DEDICATED TO UNITING THE EQUESTRIAN COMMUNITY, HONORING ACHIEVEMENT, AND MAINTAINING A SAFE AND LEVEL PLAYING FIELD FOR BOTH ITS EQUINE AND HUMAN ATHLETES. THE NMHJA CONSISTS OF 140 ACTIVE MEMBERS AND 135 ACTIVELY COMPETING HORSES. THE ASSOCIATION OFFERS 3 UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION (USEF) HORSE SHOWS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. EACH OF THESE COMPETITIONS IS PROFESSIONALLY MANAGED AND ATTRACTS EXHIBITORS FROM THE ENTIRE STATE AS WELL AS SOUTHERN COLORADO AND EAST TEXAS. THESE COMPETITIONS RANGE IN SIZE FROM 75 TO 120 COMPETING EXHIBITORS AND HORSES. THEY ALSO ATTRACT APPROXIMATELY 150 SPECTATORS, WHO MAY ONE DAY CHOOSE TO BECOME INVOLVED IN THE EQUESTRIAN COMMUNITY. THE NMHJA HORSE SHOWS ALSO PROVIDE A TRAINING VENUE FOR RIDERS THAT ASPIRE TO COMPETE ON A ZONE AND NATIONAL LEVEL.
