The fund raising program for the modernization of Recreation Center 2 was a five year program. The initial 2-3 years was collection of donations, retained in a special account until needed, and obtaining pledges to be paid over a five year period.

The remodeling contract was awarded by Leisure World Community Association board. LWF released funds based on monthly progress billings that were certified proper by LWCA. Ultimately expect to disburse all funds collected for this modernization project, about 2.5 M.
